Death and Grieving

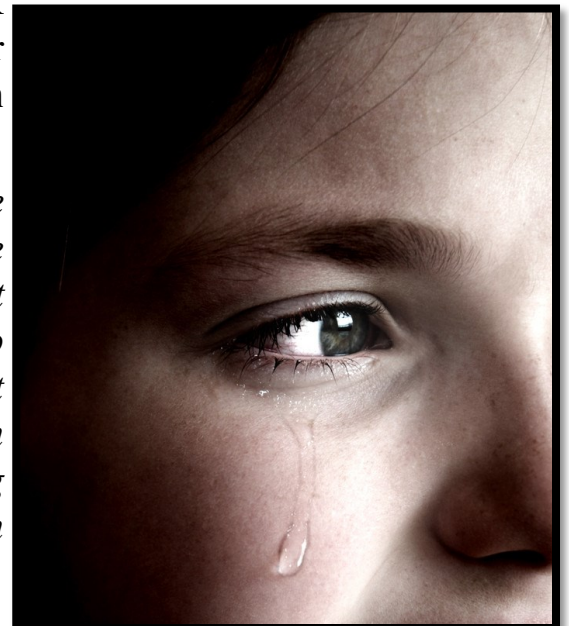

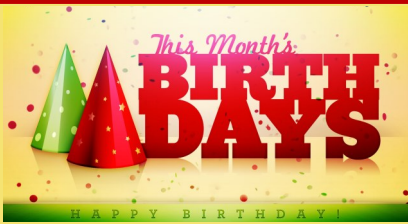
