Consumerism and the Church

Many life choices are enemies of Christianity and the Lord's church. These enemies include atheism, false religions, humanism, immorality, and selfishness. One that is pervasive, yet overlooked, is consumerism.

Consumerism in religion is the idea that Christianity and the church should serve us. “What can the church do for me and my family? What can I get out of my faith?” While these questions might be appropriate in some respects, they should not be our primary focus.

Instead, let's focus on what I can do! What can and should I do as a Christian and member of the Lord's church? How can I better worship and serve God? What should I put into my faith and obedience?

Worship is vital in the Christian life, but it is not an entertainment venue like a sporting event, stage play or movie. God is OUR focus and essentially the audience as we worship Him. While we can be encouraged in worship, let's focus on praising God in our corporate prayers, songs, giving, observance of the Lord's Supper and attention to God's Word.

Faith in God ought to include action or obedience. James wrote, “*Faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.*” (James 2:17, ESV) Remember Jesus' words in **Matthew 22:37-38** “*You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.*”³⁸ *This is the great and first commandment.*”
