# **Should I Get Vaccinated?**

From the title of this article you may have prepared yourself to either take me to task or support me for my view on the matter of COVID-19 vaccinations. If I was a medical doctor, you might listen to my advice as an "expert." If I was a talk show host, you might accept or reject my advice based on our mutual or opposing political views. If I was a nurse treating COVID-19 patients, you might receive my advice based on my first hand experience.

I am none of the above! I'm simply a preacher, husband, father, son, grand-father and Christian above all. As a preacher, I have been asked about whether or not to get vaccinated and about my views on mandates and various other "hot topics." While I am not an "expert" on these issues, I find myself going to basic Bible principles that can help.

1st, DO NOT FORGET GOD! Sadly over the last 1 1/2 years we may have lost many brethren in churches of Christ to the world. The Lord has provided the church so that we can worship God together and encourage one another. Faithfulness is something we must work on to become complete or mature as Christians. Though it may be easier to drift away from God in times of fear and uncertainty, we must be steadfast in our faith. Head the warning in Hebrews 2:1, "Therefore we must pay



closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it."

**2nd, DO NOT PROMOTE DIVISION!** When we have strong opinions on matters that are not specifically addressed in Scripture, we tend to become defensive and divisive with those whom we disagree. Let us not taint the love, forgiveness and goodwill that we are to have toward our family and especially church family. God has made it clear that we are to seek peace among our brethren and that Satan is out to destroy us. Among the many passages to consider is Romans 15:5-6, "May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, 6 that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ."

**3rd, DO NOT GIVE UP ON THE MISSION!** There is absolutely no excuse to ignore or give up on our mission to take the gospel to the world. The only end to Jesus' command in <u>Matthew 28:19-20</u>, is when Christ comes for a 2nd time to judge the world. He said, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."


