PUBLIC SCHOOL VS HOME SCHOOL

The debate between public school and home school education gets very heated at times. For the Christian, some of the concerns about public schools have been humanistic curriculum and the influence of some school employees not upholding godly and biblical standards. This has led to the advent of the home school movement which also has it's critics when poor curriculum is used or when some parents fail to provide proper educational standards for their children. Christians ought to be careful and not totally condemn either educational choice since fellow Christians are often involved in trying to provide the right education for children in our homes and in society. Many home school parents have been hurt when their choice of education is attacked. On the other hand, many public school parents and teachers have been hurt by home school parents who seem to group them into the problems of public education.

While the basic education of our children is a great concern, what is very alarming is the overall lack of basic Bible training of too many of our young people even in the church. We sometimes emphasize basic education in English, mathematics, science and history while forgetting God's directive that our children learn the Scriptures. Sadly, some of the most "educated" young people in the church are the least knowledgeable when it comes to the Bible. There is no easy way to write this than to just state: If our

children turn 18 and they know very little about God's Word, God will hold us accountable for failing to provide proper biblical spiritual training He assigned to us as parents.

While our children's schooling is important, let us make their spiritual training even more important. Here are some action items every family can work on: 1) Read and



study the Bible each week; 2) Be in Bible classes on Sundays and Wednesdays just as you demand your children be in school every day; 3) If you have a child in 2nd thru 12th grade at Weber Road, have them participate in Bible Bowl studies every Sunday evening from August through November; 4) Ask your children what they learned in Bible class; 5) Have regular discussions where the Bible is referenced; 6) Teach your children how to pray and pray often; 7) Make the Bible and knowledge of the Bible a priority in your family; 8) Start them in the cradle roll age and be dedicated until they are old enough to leave your home and begin a life on their own.

The principles of teaching God's Word to our children found in <u>Deuteronomy 6:4-9</u> still applies today in 2022. "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. 6 And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates." (ESV)




