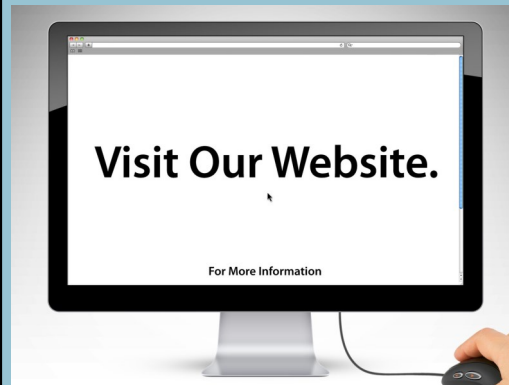
The Caldwell's Are Moving

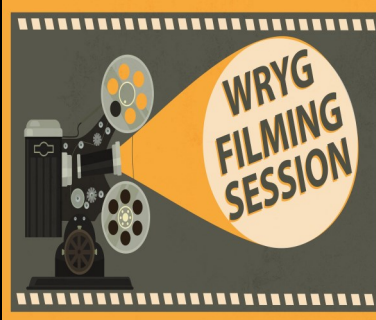

More details will be made available soon. We are still waiting on the information to come from CYC. Stay tune for details.

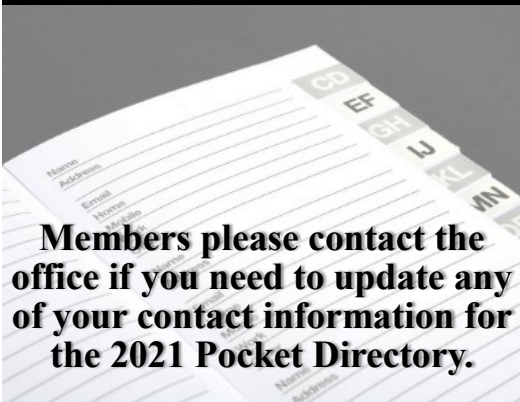


WEBER ROAD HEADLINES

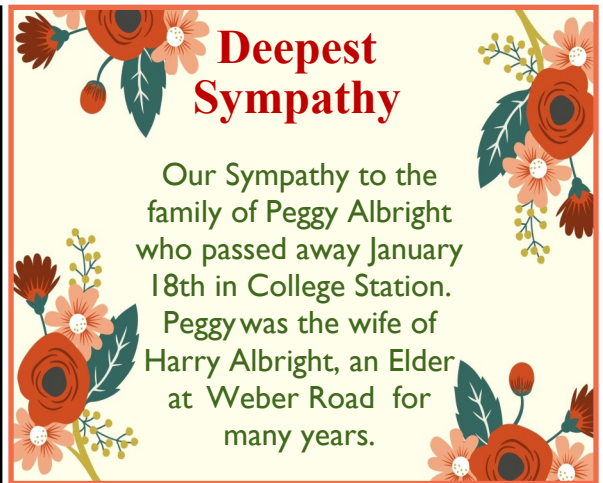
