Lessons from the Freeze

and individually members one of another." (Romans 12:4-5)

Inclement weather hit Texas and the Coastal Bend in February bringing record low temperatures for several straight days. Our northern friends might laugh at our "low" temperatures, but our homes and normal city services are not suited for such frigid conditions. Electricity went out randomly over the entire state of Texas, water pipes were bursting and basic food items became scarce in the grocery aisles. What spiritual lessons can we learn from this experience?

1st, LIFE IS FRAGILE. Stories have surfaced of individuals who died or were severely injured from the lack of heat. Children were left without milk and nutritional foods. Families were forced to endure harsh winter conditions without basic supplies. Consider how just a few days of bad weather caused panic in stores and at the gas stations. How often do we take our physical blessings for granted in a country of prosperity? It is because we cannot be sure about the longevity of our lives that we ought to turn to God in faith and obedience to His will. Paul wrote, *"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. ⁵ Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; ⁶ do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication*

with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:4-7)

2nd, FAMILY IS PRECIOUS. Many people turned to family during stressful times. Those without power and food often stayed with family members who had those things. We can be sure that



many mothers and fathers were holding their children just a little closer on cold nights. If you have centered your life on family, don't lose sight of the fact that God has blessed you with those who help in times of need. Joshua wrote, "And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." (Joshua 24:15)

3rd, WE NEED A RESET. When bad circumstances come our way, it is a good time to reset our life to make sure our priorities are in the right place. Throughout the Bible, we see how many people who faced adversity used that time to take a step back, count their blessings, repent if necessary, pray, and renew their devotion to God. As the Psalmist wrote, "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." (Psalm 51:10)
