The Polvado-Doubrava Camp Session is around the corner. The dates for camp are June 26-July 2 at Camp Bandina in Bandera, TX. Staff and


camper registration forms are in the foyer and on our church website. You can also scan the QR code located below. Staff registration deadline is May 29. Camper registration is June 12.
