Everyone is invited to our Churchwide Potluck. We are asking families to bring two of the following: meat, vegetables, salad, or desserts.

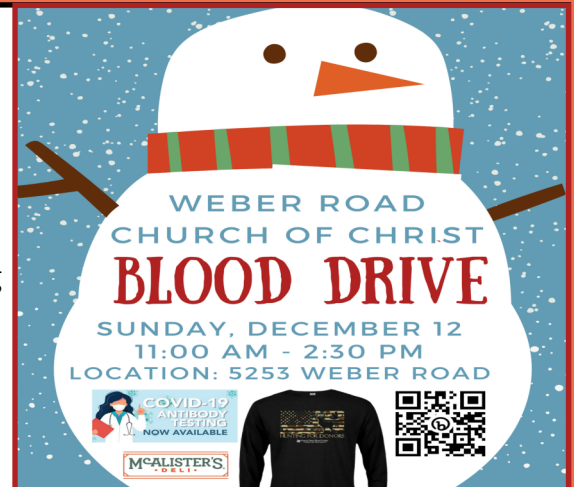
