## Time For A Check Up

According to news reports, many have neglected normal care for illnesses and diseases that require a doctor's care or a trip to the hospital because of the fear of COVID-19. This is very alarming because many are putting themselves in harms way and even facing death because of these choices. What is often true in life can also be applied to our spiritual life.

How many otherwise faithful Christians have neglected their spiritual life because of a fear particularly of COVID-19 or some other perceived danger? No matter what circumstances we face, no matter how real a threat might be, even in the face of death, we cannot neglect God and expect for Him to approve.

Here are some important questions to answer regarding our faith:

**1) Have you been faithful in your worship each Lord's Day?** We must worship God in "*Spirit and in truth*" according to Jesus ([John 4:24](#)). Just as our first century brethren worshiped on the first day of the week, we must be faithful in worshiping our Creator. Whether it is in person or by way of media streaming, stay faithful and come back "in person" ASAP.

**2) Have you continued in your Christian duties to serve God and others?** Jesus came for those who were and are spiritually sick

([Luke 5:32](#), [Mark 2:17](#)). No matter what we face or fear, we must learn to adjust to the circumstances thrown at us. Let us all find a way to carry out Jesus' commands that involve seeking and saving the lost as well as serving others.

**3) Have you been diligent to immerse yourself in the Word of God?** God's Word will guide us and nourish us if we not only study but also put it into practice daily. Have you and your children continued to learn from the Bible? Remember [Hebrews 4:12](#), "*For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.*" (ESV)
