# McRage On Display

Several years ago, I was in the drive-thru line at McDonalds for lunch, listening to sports radio, when a man in a sports car cut in line by forcing his way in front of the lady ahead of me. You might imagine how upset this young woman was as she honked her horn several times. Just a few seconds later, she swerved out of line and squealed her tires as she disappeared around the restaurant, presumably to speed off down the road in anger. That's when I heard the crash! Yes, she rear-ended another car near to the drive-thru window. As I paid for my food, I could see this woman getting a toddler out of his car seat in the back of her SUV. She was visibly angry until her husband showed up when she began to cry as if none of this was her fault. Witnessing McRage in real life got me thinking about uncontrolled anger.

Scripture tells us that uncontrolled anger is very dangerous and is ungodly. James 1:19-20 tells us, "Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; <sup>20</sup> for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God." (ESV)

The expectation from God is that we should learn and practice self-control. It does not always come easy, but it will be easier the more you work at it. The band REM came out with a song many years ago with lyrics, "Everybody



hurts sometimes" so, "hold on." This is a true statement that should be remembered when the temptation to let your temper fly off the handle presents itself. Give others the benefit of the doubt and give them the same respect that you would like to receive even when you are having your worst of days.

Remember, God expects for Christians to control themselves. Here are several passages which will help. "A hot-tempered man stirs up strife, but he who is slow to anger quiets contention." (Prov 15:18) "Refrain from anger and forsake wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil." (Ps 37:8) "Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. <sup>32</sup> Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you." (Eph 4:31-32)

While many words of advice can be given regarding anger and rage, remember that self-control is the key to controlling our emotions and possible outbursts. May the Lord be with you as you work to be His faithful child! -Mark Hammitt
