Will There Be A Rapture?

Whenever there is a major global conflict or catastrophic event, the RAPTURE is proclaimed by both well meaning people and those who knowingly profess false teaching. In this article, let's briefly examine if there will be a RAPTURE.

The RAPTURE certainly has gained widespread attention with books, movies, TV shows, podcasts and more which promote the view of God taking certain people suddenly and then eventually establishing an earthly reign of 1,000 years on earth. According to this teaching, Israel will be the place where Christ will rule from His throne. While there are many other aspects to this belief system, the answer to the title's question is emphatically, "NO!" There will not be a "RAPTURE" as taught from many pulpits and podcasts throughout the religious world.

Jesus said there will be exactly ONE final resurrection (John 5:28-29). When Christ comes again, it will not be in secret, but it will be for ALL to see (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18). Old Testament prophecies concerning the kingdom of God from the Messiah (Jesus Christ) have been fulfilled (Luke 1:15, 9:1; Acts 2:36-38; John 18:36). 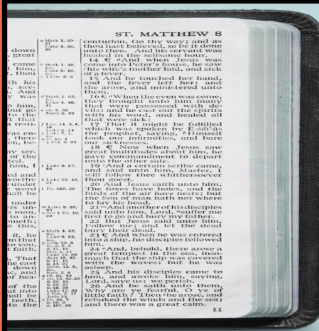
Thanks to everyone who helped at the Church Workday on Saturday. Work was done inside and outside. We hope to have another workday in the Springtime.
