One of the special times each week at Weber Road is our **5:00 PM** worship assembly. Every Weber Road member is encouraged to join your church family as the new year approaches on Sunday afternoons.

Each Sunday at **5:00 PM** we sing together, pray, hear a message from God's Word, and those who were unable to observe the Lord's Supper or give as prospered earlier in the day are given opportunity to do so. We also have assigned each Sunday of the month with an emphasis as follows.

First Sunday: One of our **ELDERS** shares a message of encouragement and a spiritual challenge with the congregation.

Second Sunday: We emphasize **SINGING**. Many men, young and older, have an opportunity to lead songs. Requests are taken from those in attendance.

Third Sunday: PRAYER is our emphasis. A prayer focusing on praise to God and confession of sins is offered. Another special prayer to remember our sick, bereaved, shut-ins, missionaries and preaching students is led.



Fourth Sunday: There is a time for **SERVICE**. Worship is shorter in length and afterwards we have opportunities for special service such as writing cards of encouragement, visitation, or special projects around the building.

Fifth Sundays: Our **YOUNG MEN LEAD WORSHIP**. This is a wonderful way to encourage our young people and to equip them to lead in the future.

Each Sunday at 5:00 PM **CHILDREN'S BIBLE HOUR** is available for children 10 years old and under. Thomas Brinn has agreed to organize Bible Hour and he appreciates any volunteers. Please see Thomas if you can help in any way.

As 2024 approaches, will you make worship on Sundays at **5:00 PM** part of your weekly routine? We hope to see you each week!

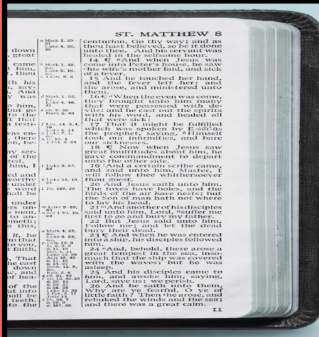


