Commercials showing children in third world countries that are malnourished can be traumatic. With all the food available to Americans, it's hard to imagine the desperation of those who have literally nothing. We've seen the pictures of children with bloated bellies, discolored teeth, flies all over their skin and extremities that make them look like walking skeletons. Perhaps you have found a way to help, but the task seems insurmountable.

Another very disturbing trend in our own society is that children are growing up in our communities and even churches who are, in effect, spiritually malnourished. Although God's Word is readily available and worship is open to everyone each Lord's Day, there are countless children who are not getting the godly nourishment they need to grow "in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and man," as Jesus did. (Luke 2:52)

We all know the eventual outcome after years of being malnourished. Sickness, disease, deformities and death will come sooner than later. The same is true on a spiritual level. Friends, we must devote our time as parents, grandparents and guardians to providing our children with the life giving feast that is the Word of God.

Here's what you can do: 1) Bring them to Bible classes on Sundays and Wednesdays; 2) Take them to worship every Sunday for AM and PM worship; 3) Read Bible stories during the week; 4) Listen regularly to Bible based acapella music; 5) Pray with your children. Do everything within your power to bring them up in the Lord. While immediate benefits may not be seen in doing these things, the proper nourishment over time will surely reap spiritually healthy rewards.

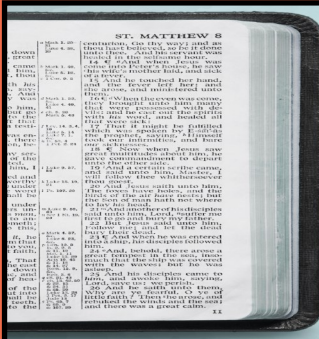

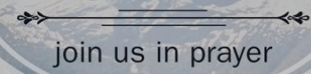
