FOOLISH WISDOM?

This will be a controversial statement in many circles, but it must be stated. "ANY institution of learning or education that leaves out God and godly principles promotes 'Foolish Wisdom!'" This is true of any home, public or private school, college or university, even churches or religious institutions. One might ask, "how can wisdom be foolish?"

The apostle Paul addressed the supposed wisdom of man, that is devoid of God, in <u>I</u> <u>Corinthians 3:18-20</u>. "Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you thinks that he is wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise. ¹⁹ For the wisdom of this world is folly with God. For it is written, "He catches the wise in their craftiness," ²⁰and again, "The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile." (ESV)

We often stress the importance of education to help us progress in life. That is to be commended when it comes to pursuing jobs that provide for our families. Even the most basic subjects of math, science, language and history help us to understand society and how to deal with life, even the more difficult parts of life. Yet, God wants us to know that man's wisdom is truly foolish unless it is founded upon and instilled with the wisdom of God. It breaks my heart to hear of children who grew up in the church and



"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. ⁵ You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶ And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸ You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹ You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates." <u>Deuteronomy 6:4-9</u>
