Wait a Minute! Are You Serious?

The title of this article is the reaction some have to Jesus' command to His followers found in Luke 6:27-28. "But I say to you who hear, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, ²⁸ bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you." (ESV) Let's break this passage down into three statements regarding the love we must have toward our enemies.

First, "do good to those who hate you." We are not just to refrain from hating them in return, we are to DO GOOD to them. What about the bully at school or the coworker who is ugly to you? Jesus says we must look for opportunities to repay their abuse with kindness. That is a BIG command, but one that we must follow to please our God.

Second, "bless those who curse you." Here is another difficult command when you consider the attitude we are to develop as Christians. When someone curses you, the response from our mind and lips must be to

remember that God loves them and wants us to bless or wish them well. Perhaps the "natural" inclination is to curse them back, but that should not be the action of a faithful child of God.

Third, "pray for those who abuse you." Here is a "doozy" which means something outstanding or unique. When is the last time you



prayed for the neighbor who damaged your property in some way? When is the last evening prayer when you approached God on behalf of your child's bully and his/her family? What about prayers for any abusive person in your life? Some might think, "that's going too far!" But, it's extremely hard to make excuses and justify ignoring Jesus' words in this passage. He expects obedience.

While this may be one of the toughest passages in the Bible, it must be lived out every day of our life in Christ, our Lord and Savior. Jesus commands and fully expects His people to LOVE THEIR ENEMIES! Will you follow the Lord's command?

B. Are you able to even love your enemies as Jesus instructed? Mt 5:21-22, 43-44; Lk 6:27-36; I Jn 4:20)


IV. What do you think about Y_____?

- A. Judgment is coming! (Mt 7)
