### A LOOK IN THE MIRROR

I would suspect that one of the first things you do every morning is look into the mirror. What do you see? Probably one or more of the following: a head full of hair that's sticking up in all directions, a complexion that may require make up, teeth that need brushing, or possibly a face that needs to be shaved. Can you imagine leaving that house every morning and completely forgetting what you look like? No! You've been looking at the same face all your life so you know exactly what you look like very well, every scar and blemish.

In the Book of James, he uses this illustration to describe a person who reads God's Word and fails to apply it to his/her life. Read <u>James 1:22-25</u>, "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. <sup>23</sup> For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. <sup>24</sup> For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. <sup>25</sup> But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing." (ESV)

James is making the point that when we read and hear the Word of God, we are expected to obey! The question for each of us is: "What do you see in yourself as you examine God's Word?" Hopefully we see the things that God wants us to change. Let the Bible shape and mold you into a more complete and

mature Christian who looks more and more like our Savior and example, Jesus Christ.

When you were a child looking into a mirror, you saw a child staring back at you. As you age, that image gets older and the signs of aging will appear more and more. Wrinkles will come, hair may become gray or fall out, skin becomes more blemished, and that image staring back at you



will eventually be that of an older man or woman. For the Christian, as we look into the spiritual mirror that is the Word of God, that image staring back at us will also age and mature into a more devoted and faithful child of God. That is, IF! IF we are a "doer who acts!" (James 1:25) That is what God expects of all those who would call themselves faithful.
