
UNINTENDED CONSEQUENCES

The law of unintended consequences is well known in social sciences. This is simply the fact that for anything we do we might anticipate the results, but there are also results that cannot be anticipated. Why bring this up in a church bulletin? We call our bulletin the "Family Encourager" for a reason, it is intended to help our church family grow in faith and closer to one another. We only grow if we push ourselves, evaluate our lives, and strive every day to follow God's direction. This article is meant to encourage all who read it to be faithful to God no matter what circumstances we face in life.

For the past two years we have been faced with decisions that have had a profound impact on the faith of many. While many of you have continued to grow in faith by regular worship each Lord's Day (in person or streaming), showing Christian service to others, and working to become more Christ-like; some of you may have struggled in your faith terribly. If you have been faithful, may you continue to grow and shine as lights to the world for our Savior! (Matt 5:16; Phil 2:15)


