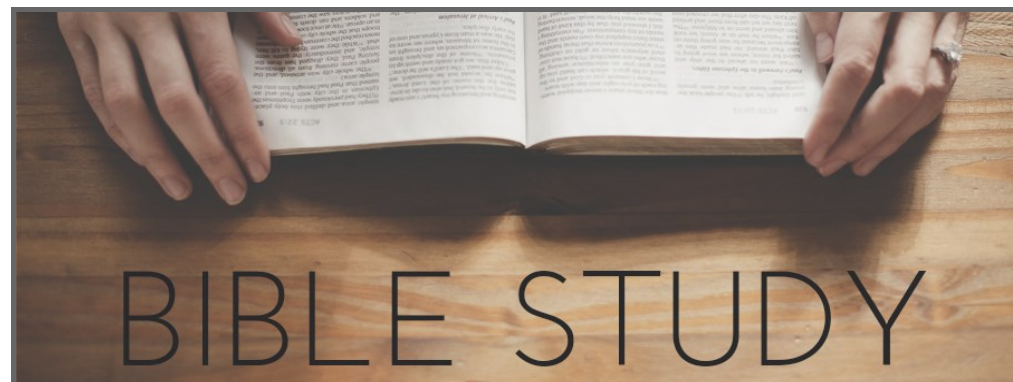

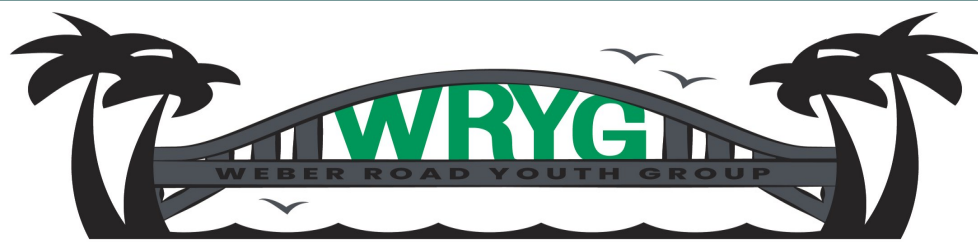

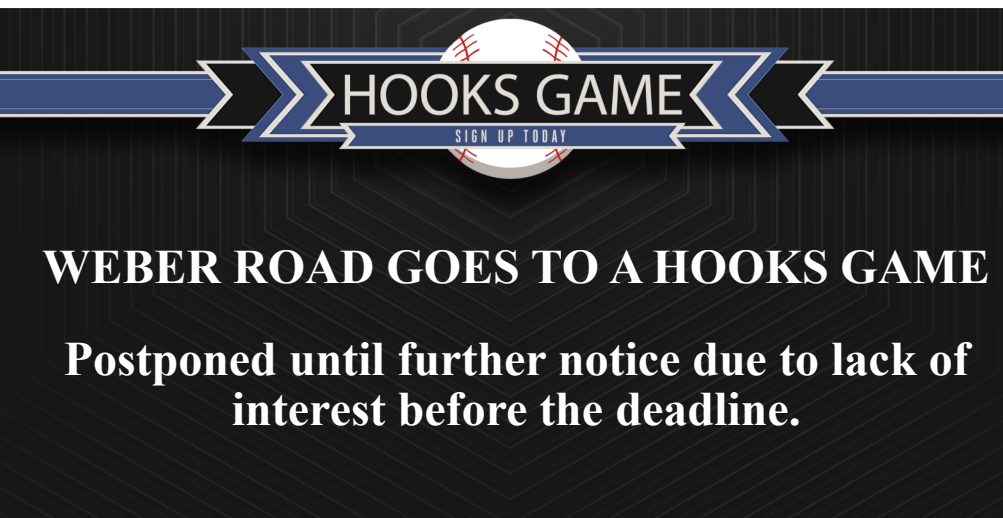


Food Pantry Drive

We are working on replenishing our Food Pantry. A complete list of items needed can be found in the bulletin or on the bulletin board in the foyer.

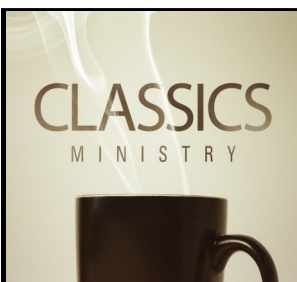

April 21 | 10 AM

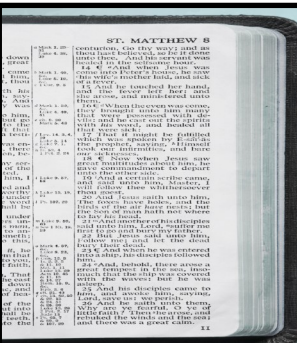
