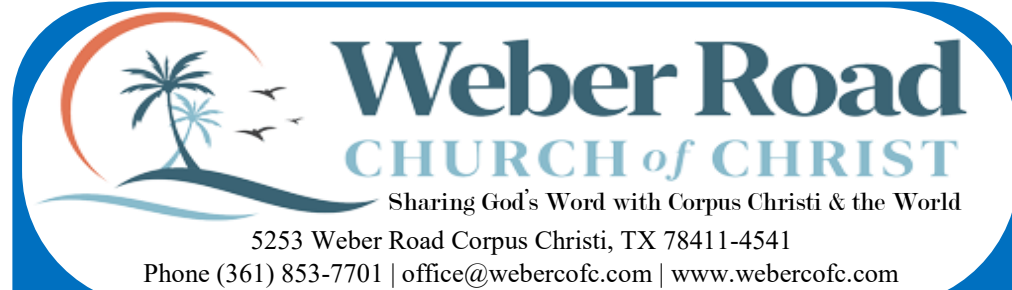

## Vegetable Garden Season

<sup>6</sup> Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, <sup>7</sup> rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving. Colossians 2:6-7 [ESV]

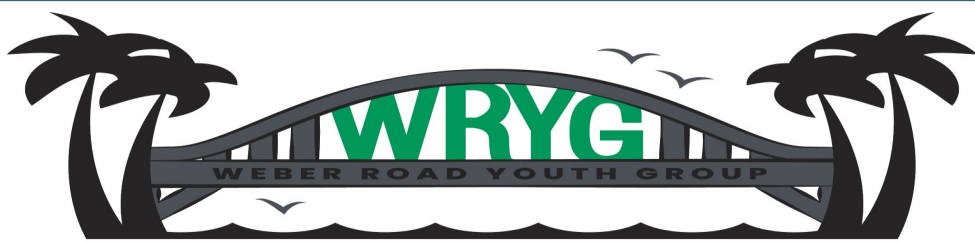
This year many have started to build and plant a vegetable garden. It is fun to watch the seed develop and grow into a small plant. It will be even better to watch that little seed develop into a plant that produces a crop.

A good garden starts with good soil. The soil provides nutrients through the roots to plant. That soil needs to be worked and tended. Christians need to be rooted in our faith of our Lord and Savior. We need to develop deep roots.

Certain plants need to be pruned. The pruning process helps the plant to grow. Tomato plants have sucker limbs, while some of these limbs can produce tomatoes, but they can also rob the plant from the necessary nutrients. Herbs benefit from the pruning process. Pruning removes part of the plant in order to strengthen the plant. A Christian needs to look inward to find things to remove (Eph 4, Col 3). This process is hard. This process is challenging. At times we may need to eliminate friends, or family. We may need to remove a sin that we have held onto for years.

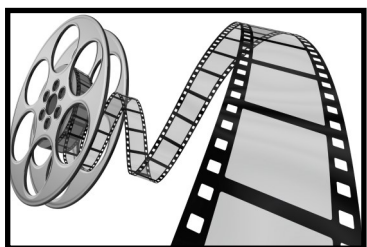

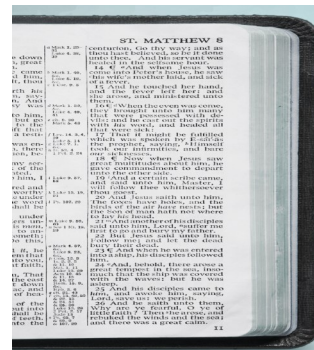
