

## Is the Doctrine of Original Sin Biblical?

Romans 5; Ezekiel 18; Psalms 51

### I. History of this Teaching

- Widely accepted for at least \_\_\_\_\_ years that the sin of A\_\_\_\_\_ and P\_\_\_\_\_ was not passed on to others
- A\_\_\_\_\_ was a proponent of inherited sin and the Council of T\_\_\_\_\_ made it accepted doctrine in 1545 within Catholicism
- It is found in the P\_\_\_\_\_ Book of Confessions

### II. Bible Teaching Concerning Inherited Sin

- F\_\_\_\_\_ is always offered to those who C\_\_\_\_\_ sin
- In Romans 5, Paul is discussing J\_\_\_\_\_ through C\_\_\_\_\_
  - Christ died for U\_\_\_\_\_ sinners (v 8)
  - Sin and D\_\_\_\_\_ entered the world through A\_\_\_\_\_ and A\_\_\_\_\_ men sin (v 12)
  - Also, through O\_\_\_\_\_ man came J\_\_\_\_\_ (v 18)
  - N\_\_\_\_\_ is said about sin being P\_\_\_\_\_ on to another!
- In Ezekiel 18 starts with, "F\_\_\_\_\_ have eaten sour grapes, and the C\_\_\_\_\_ teeth are set on edge" (v 2) Three truths are found in the remainder of the chapter:
  - Man who lives R\_\_\_\_\_ - He shall L\_\_\_\_\_ (vs 4-9)
  - A S\_\_\_\_\_ who forgets his F\_\_\_\_\_ righteousness and does E\_\_\_\_\_ - He shall D\_\_\_\_\_ (vs 10-13)
  - A G\_\_\_\_\_ who turns from his F\_\_\_\_\_ wickedness and does G\_\_\_\_\_ - He shall L\_\_\_\_\_ (vs 14-17)
  - "The S\_\_\_\_\_ who S\_\_\_\_\_ shall die" (v 20)
- David wrote, "Behold I was brought forth in I\_\_\_\_\_ and in S\_\_\_\_\_ did my M\_\_\_\_\_ conceive me" (Psalm 51)
  - David is saying that he was B\_\_\_\_\_ into a corrupt world and sees the universal N\_\_\_\_\_ of sin
  - There are many plain passages that show the I\_\_\_\_\_ of I\_\_\_\_\_ and Y\_\_\_\_\_ C\_\_\_\_\_
  - What about C\_\_\_\_\_ Himself? (Lk 1:31)

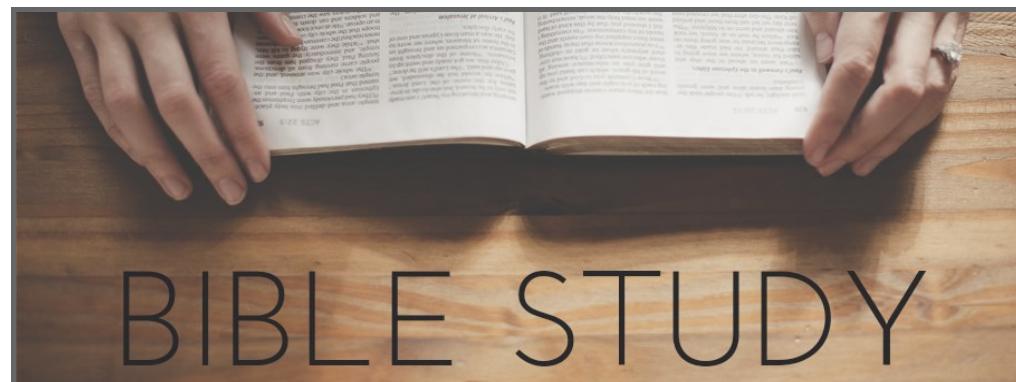
### III. Other Problems To Be Solved
