

It was three days after they saw their Rabbi die a horrific death on the cross. The believed with all their heart that Jesus was to redeem all of Israel. He was to raise the physical nation up and become a mighty nation again. Yet they witnessed Him breathe his last breath and offer up His Spirit. These two men were returning home from Passover filled with sorrow. They lost their hope of redemption.

Loosing hope effects us deeply. We feel sorrowful. We want to give up. The days are darker. These two men as well as the other disciples of Jesus felt this same hopeless feeling after seeing and hearing the tomb being empty. Yet that tomb being empty gives hope for the whole world.
