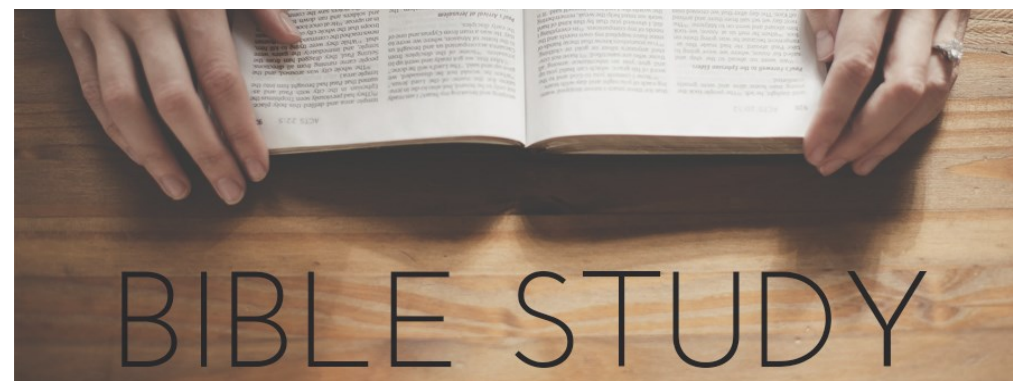

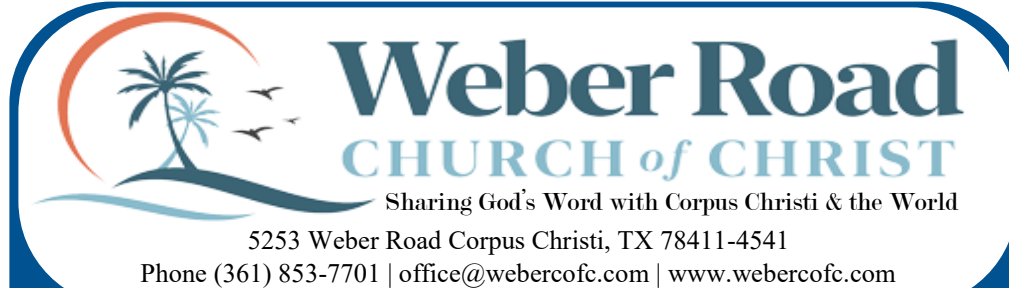

"I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."
Galatians 2:20 (ESV)

We sometimes sing this song in Bible Hour or at youth events. We sing it a little faster each go around. It is one that many have fun singing. Yet have we focused on the words or do we sing it out of fun? These words have power and meaning. We all need to be able to sing these words boldly and honestly. We must all say that I have crucified my old life and that person no longer lives. But Christ lives in me. I am living by faith in the Song of God. Paul writes this to reaffirm his identity in Christ. Paul knew and understood that his identity was in Christ. Have you ever asked the question, who am I? What is my identity? Have you ever acted one way in one setting but opposite in another? Have you ever been lead away by the influence of someone else? Let's take a moment and look at the previous verses.

In order to gain a better understanding of this verse we must look at the context surrounding it. Paul starts this section explaining his confrontation with Cephas, or Peter. We are all familiar with Peter. Peter was a great apostle, he was an elder, and he was one that everyone knew and looked up to as an example. Yet in this context Paul confronts him. Why? Peter stood condemned! Why? Because he ate with the Gentiles, but when other Jews were present he left the gentiles to eat with the Jews. Peter had such influence on others that he lead others into hypocrisy, even Barnabas (the great encourager).

Paul knew his identity! Paul had put away his past life as a Pharisee of Pharisee. Paul crucified the old life that he use to live in order to gain Christ. Peter was still holding on to the past life. Peter had forgotten his identity for a moment. I pray that you never forget your identity in Christ. I pray that you put away the former way of life. I pray that you live by faith, because the Son of God loves you and gave Himself for you!

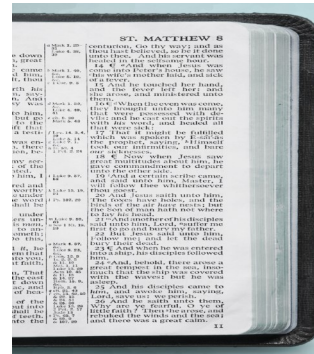
