

Victory Through Prayer

Matthew 6:9-13; Luke 11:2-4

- "Rock and a Hard Place" - "Gethsemane"
- "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples" (Lk 11:1)
- Jesus' Model for Prayer (not to be recited from memory, but a pattern to follow after (see Matt 6:7, 9)

I. Reverently Addressing Our God

- A. Have an attitude of reverence and awe (Isa 6:3)
- B. Like David in 1 Chronicles 29:10-13
- C. Jesus is praised according to Revelation 5, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive...honor and glory..."

II. Humbly Praying for God's Will to be Done

- A. Psalm 143:10, "Teach me to do your will..."
- B. What is God's will for you? (see 1 Thess 4:3; 5:18)
- C. God's will is knowable and provable (Rom 12:2)

III. Earnestly Praying for His Daily Blessings

- A. The Lord listens to prayers anytime we approach Him
- B. Ask for more than just material needs (Mt 6:33; Ja 1:17)

IV. Fervently Asking for Forgiveness

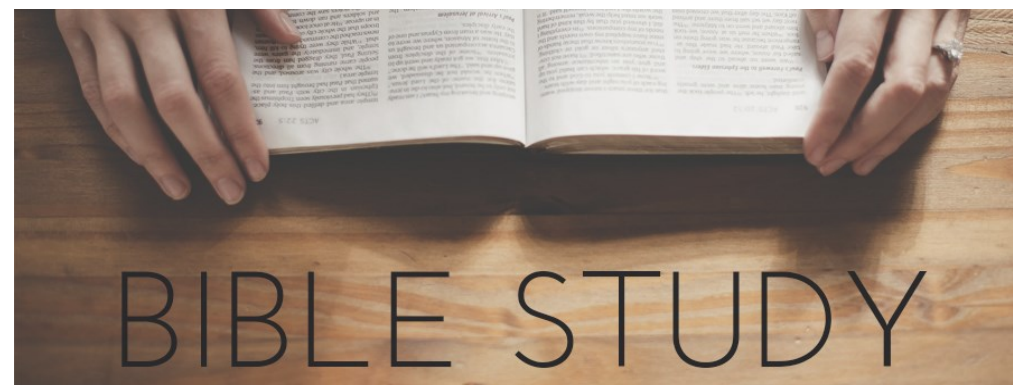
- A. We long to be forgiven, but we often withhold it to others
- B. Many Bible passages stress our need to be forgiven (i.e. Mt 6:13; 1 Jn 1:9; Ps 51; Ps 71)
- C. We must seek God's wisdom and unselfish nature

V. Our Development in Prayer

- A. Why aren't prayers always answered to our satisfaction?
- B. It's vital to find your "inner room" where you can pray earnestly and uninterrupted (Mt 6:6)
- C. We must ask for the Lord's will to be done and accept whatever His will might be (Mk 11:24; Jn 14:13-14, Jn 15:7,16; Jn 16:23-24)

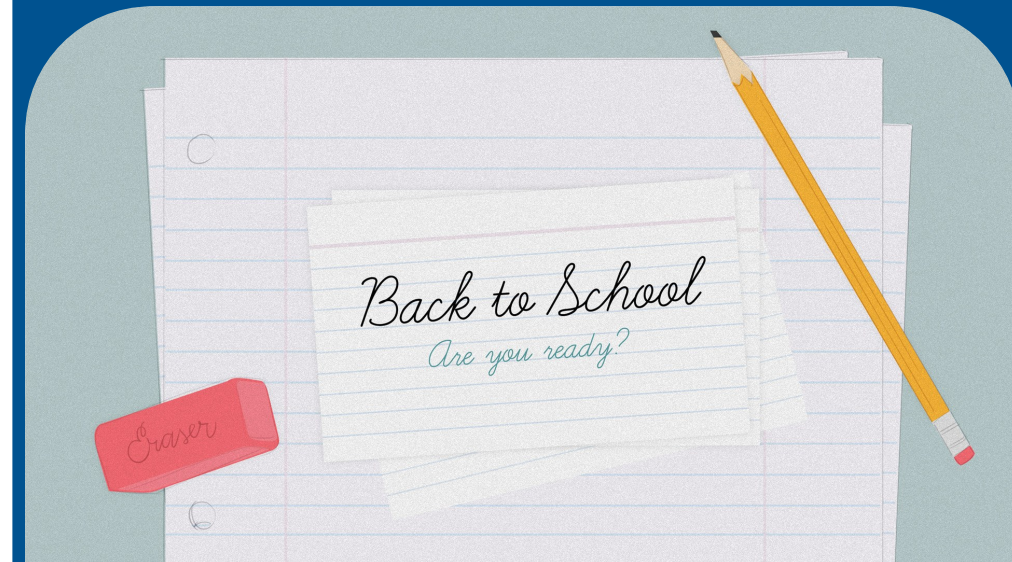
