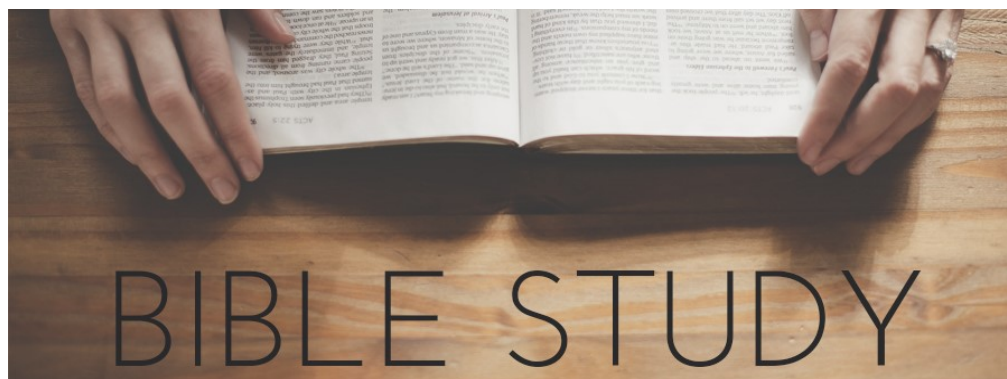

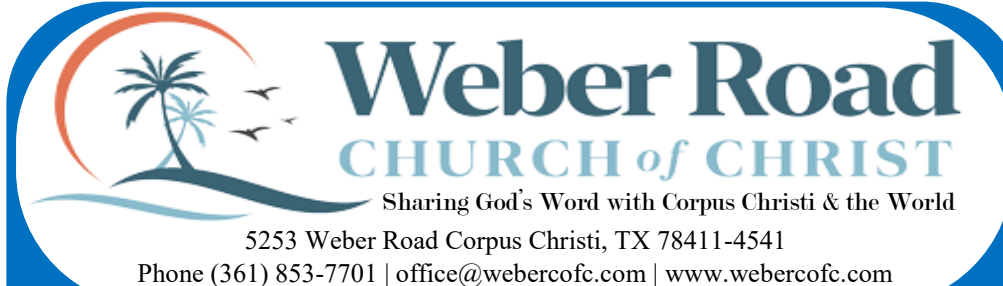

Children through 5th grade may bring a pre-wrapped gift (\$10 limit) with a label of age and for boy/girl to share.



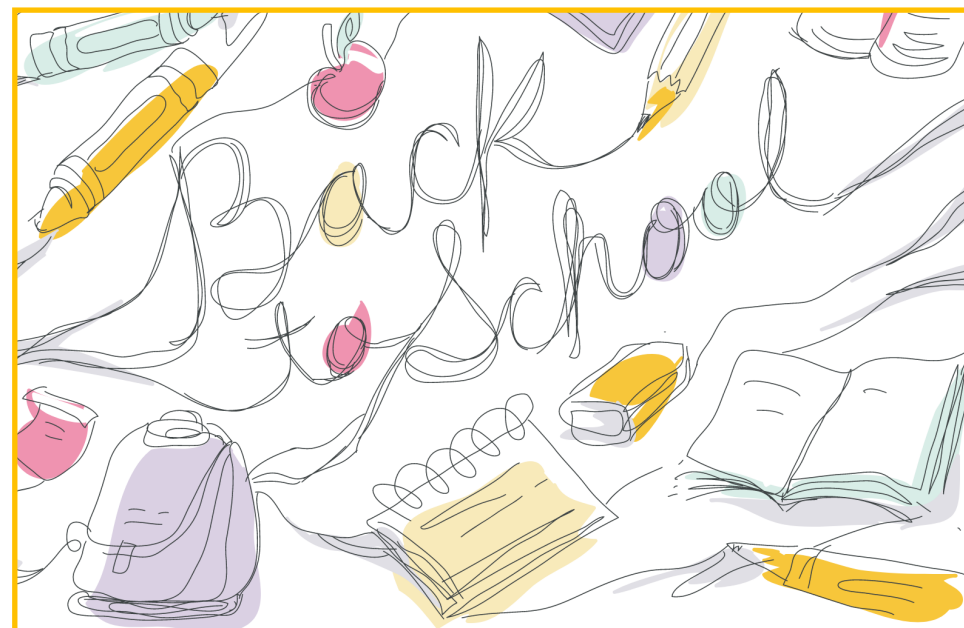
