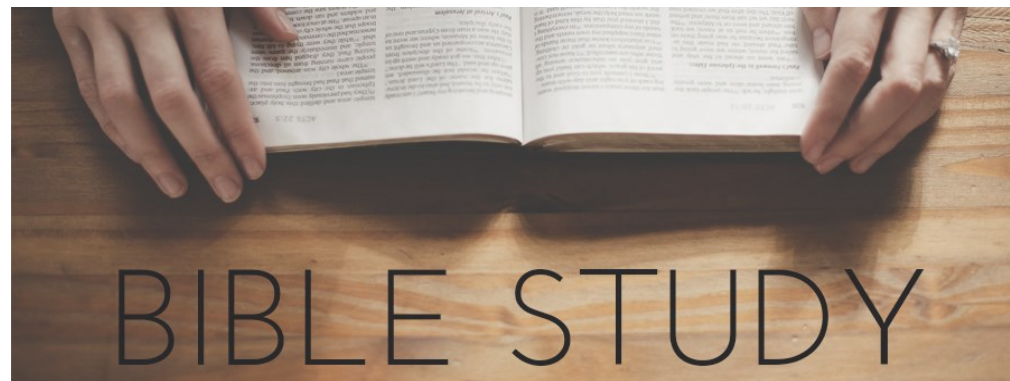

This event will run from 3:00 to 5:00 PM, and if you are volunteering for hosting a craft, we ask that you come in around 2:30 for set-up.

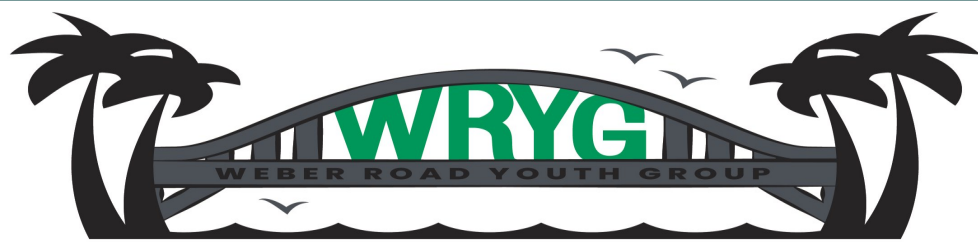
The success of any event depends on the church body! So there is a sign-up sheet for other volunteer opportunities as well which will help make this a success, including bringing finger/snack food or drink items.

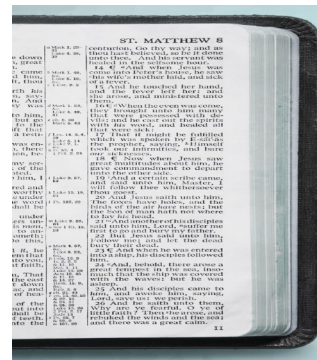
