There is a beautiful story about giving in Mark 12:38-44. The context of the story is simple. Jesus was watching others give money back to God, but this poor widow gave what most would consider an insignificant amount in the offering. The point Jesus makes is very much applicable to us today. Yes, we as Christians, are challenged to give back to the work of the Lord. Yet the heart of giving is much more significant than the amount we are giving. After Jesus saw this woman's offering, he told his disciples that this woman gave more than anyone else. Why is that? How could something seemingly insignificant be more significant?

It is a heart issue. The others were giving out of their abundance, but this woman gave everything. Christians are challenged to give generously and sacrificially. When we give monetarily, the church can support a variety of works and missions. Yet, we can also give of our time and effort. Jesus also said the fields are ripe for the harvest. 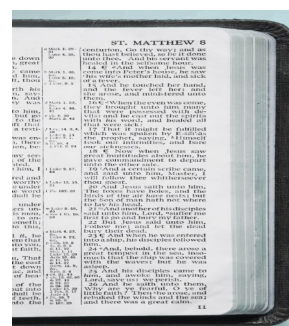
