<sup>4</sup> Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant <sup>5</sup> or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; <sup>6</sup> it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup> Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. <sup>8</sup> Love never ends - 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 [ESV]

**What is love?** This simple question can have multiple answers. It can be hard to simplify this question to a short sentence. It is hard to describe love. For one, love means different ideas to different people. I love Jennifer and Bryant, but I also love our dogs. I love my parents differently than I love my friends. ## YOUTH GROUP EVENTS [6th-12th grades]

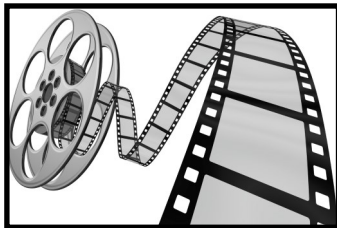
### **CYC WATCH PARTY- February 26-28**

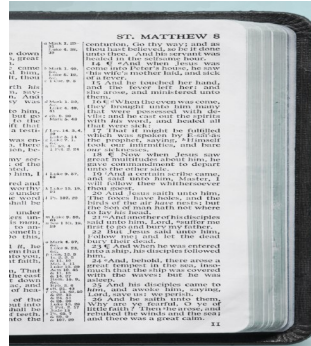
