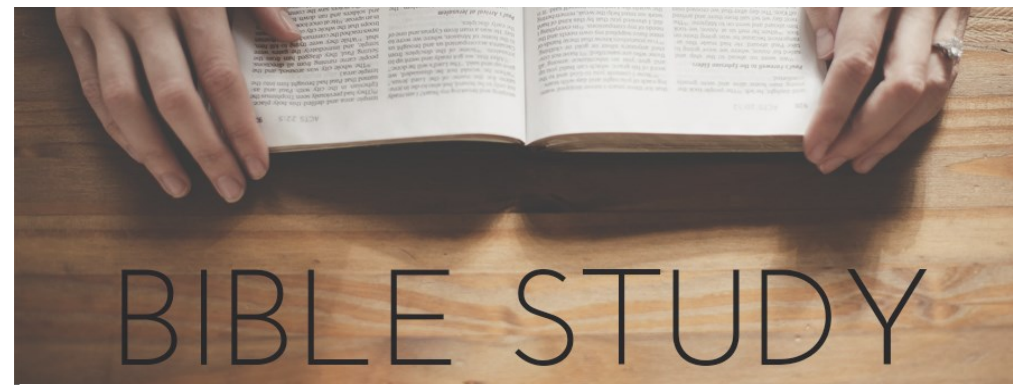

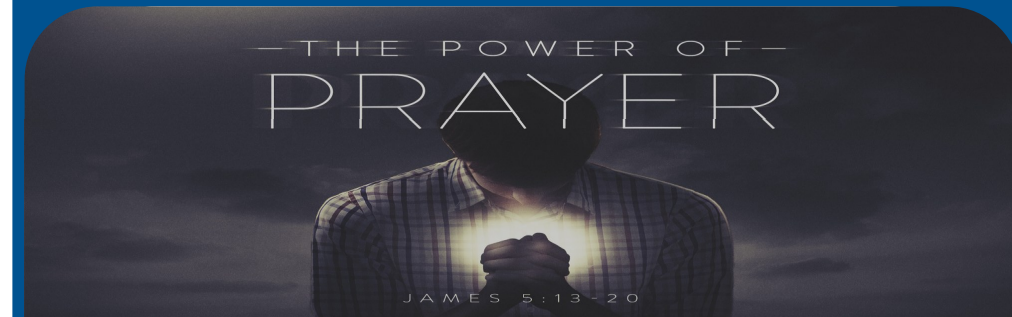

This popped up as a memory from 2 years ago (I think it is still fitting):

Recently we studied from James 5:12-18 for our devotional. I want to share something that is on my heart. One of my professors at FHU said "always preach to yourself first." As I lay my head down these verses are speaking louder and louder. I know there are many struggling in life right now. I heard this past week of a dear family going through medical issues. I know other families dealing with the loss of someone dear. I know others are dealing with depression, anxiety, suicide, or addiction. I want you to know that you are being lifted up! God wants you to cast your anxiety on Him (1 Peter 5:7). Jesus says take my yoke upon you because it is easy and light, let me take your heavy load (Matthew 11:22-30). If you are suffering, go to your loving Father in prayer. Let Him hear you!

There is a song that comes on K-love with a line that says "I will praise you in this storm." A dear friend told me an enlightened thought I want to share. After Jesus institutes the Lord Supper in the upper room, He and the Apostles sang a hymn. A simple statement with profound meaning. Jesus knew that in a few hours, He would endure tremendous physical and emotional pain. Pain from the betrayal, the denial, and the abandonment. Pain from the lashing, the crown, the thorns, and suffocating on the cross. Yet in the midst of it all, He sang praise to God. Paul and Silas in the Philippian jail, sang hymns praising God. Today, if you are struggling pray but also sing praise to our God. My heart will join you in singing praise to Him. Do you need prayers?

"Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise. Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working." James 5:13-16 (ESV) -Kenneth

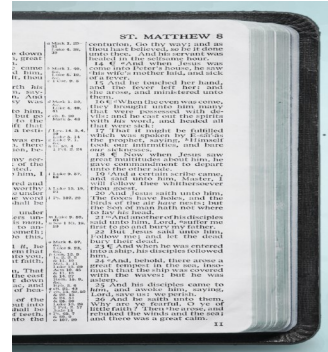
