In Need! Have you ever felt in need? In need of water after a hot summer day in South Texas? In need to food after a serious workout? In need of a change of pace after a major project? In need of a pay raise as your boss continues to load more work on your plate? In need of more space to accommodate your stuff?

In Romans 3, we read that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. In Romans 6, we read that the wages of sin is death. We understand that we are "in need" to have these wages paid. In 1 John 2, we read that Jesus is our advocate, our mediator, our propitiation for our sins. He is the Savior we need. Yet God does not promise that life will be easy after baptism. We can look throughout scripture to prove this idea. David was a man after God's own heart and his life was difficult. The Apostles were killed for proclaiming the Gospel.

So what do we do when we are "in need" during trying times. Are we still "in need" when things are going smoothly? How do you handle everything in any and every circumstance? Let us look toward the Apostles. While Peter was sinking in the water during the storm, he cried out to Jesus to save him. Each of these examples shows that we must turn to the Lord. Paul writes in Philippians 4:10-13 "10 I rejoiced in the Lord greatly that now at length you have revived your concern for me. You were indeed concerned for me, but you had no opportunity. 11 Not that I am speaking of being in need, for I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. 12 I know how to be brought low, and I know how to abound. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need. 13 I can do all things through him who strengthens me." Are you going through a difficult storm? You are in need of Jesus! Are you blessed with a job, a nice car, a house, and other countless blessings? You are in need of Jesus.

Sunday, March 21 [6-8 PM]

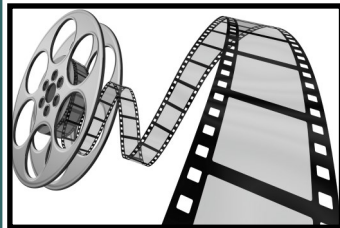

MOVIE NIGHT -

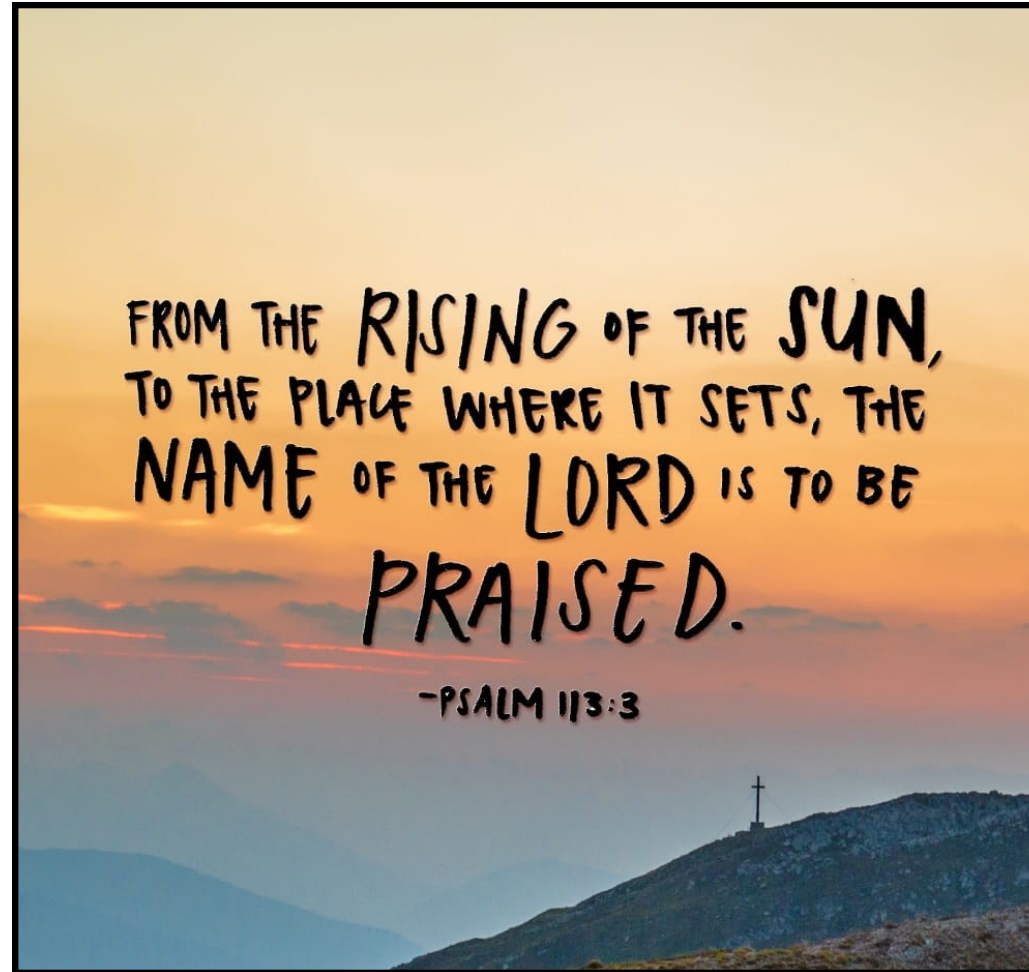
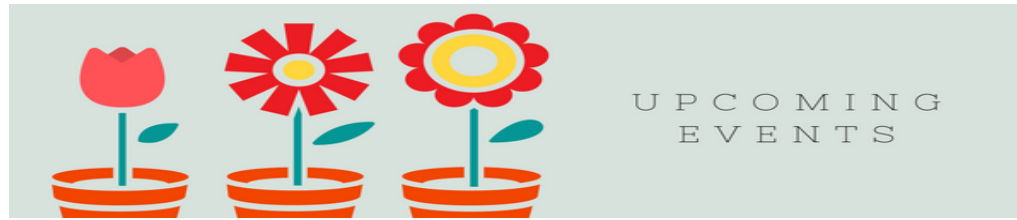
