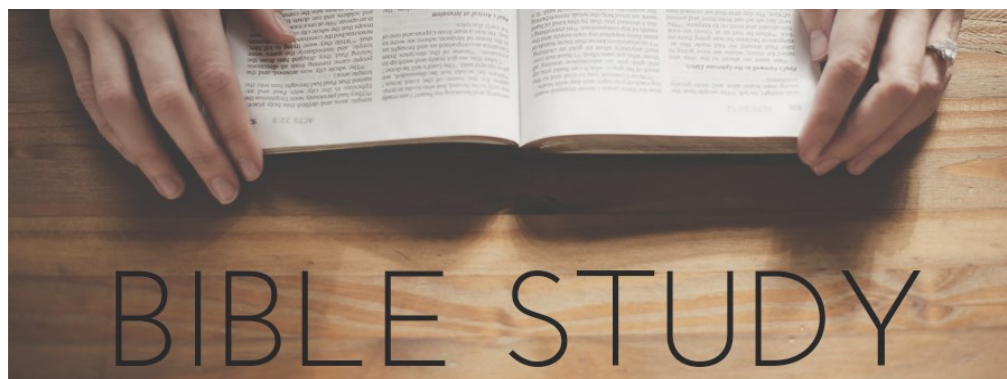

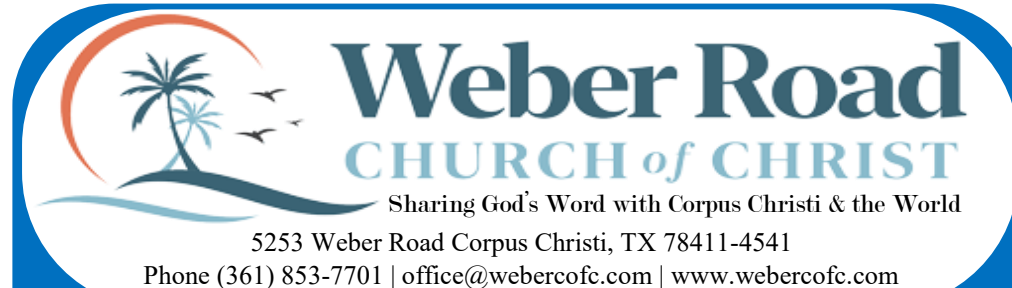

BIBLE BOWL STUDY - January 10 [5-6 PM]

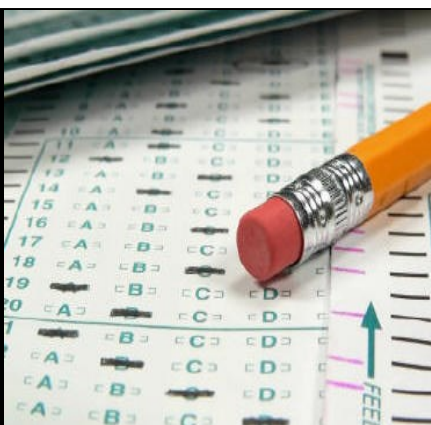
Tonight is our last study session for Bible Bowl. We will study the last two chapters and review. If you are staying for the devotional after, please bring your own dinner.

YOUTH DEVOTIONAL - February 7 [6-8 PM]

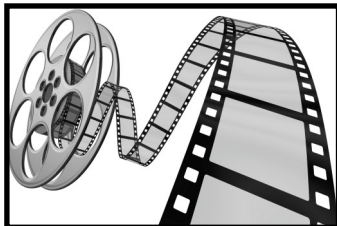
Our next Youth devotional and filming session. Bring your own dinner. We will finish by 8 PM.
