

"Be careful little eyes what you see Oh be careful little ears what you hear For the Father up above is looking down with love So be careful little lips what you say."

For the little children, we sing this song often. We try to teach them an important truth in a simple song. Yet as an older Christian, I have realized the more I need this reminder in my life. I want to take a little time to reexamine this song to teach us some Biblical truths.

"Be careful little eyes what you see." When sin first entered the world, it is noted that Eve noticed the forbidden fruit was pleasing to the eye. In 1 John 2:16, John warns us of the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the boastful pride of life. Sin is pleasing to the eye. David saw Bathsheba bathing on her roof and she was beautiful. Jesus spoke on the sermon on the mount that if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out because it is better to go to heaven without an eye than to sin.

I am sure we understand that we must control our sight. Yet it is difficult to control. Last year, we spent the year focusing on our Spiritual Vision. The best solution for controlling our sight is looking at things through God's eyes. *Psalms 119:18 "Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law."* Colossians 3:1-4, explains that we need to focus our thoughts, minds, hearts, vision on things above where Christ is seated. Hebrews 12:2, further proves that we need to fix our eyes on Jesus. If we focus on Jesus and things above our eyes will understand the temptation of sin and move us away from the temptation and closer to God.



#### **CYC WATCH PARTY- February 26-28**


We are currently making plans to watch CYC at the Church building. Stay tuned for more details and information in the coming weeks. The theme this year is *In Need*.
