



Last summer, we witnessed some of the worst wildfires in recent years. Some fires started by nature, others by campsites, and one by a gender reveal party. In 2020, there was 4.2 million acres burned in the wildfire season. Now there are several reasons why these fires are getting worse but it is interesting that some of these large fires are started with just a small spark.

We read in James 3, about the power of our tongues. Our tongues, while small, are quite powerful. We have the ability to encourage and bless someone one minute and curse and belittle them the next. There was an old saying that "sticks and stones may break my bones, but words will never hurt me." Many of us have realized this saying is not true. James is warning us in this chapter to be careful what we say to one another.

Another concept about "be careful little mouth what you say", that is pertinent is the words we use everyday. In Ephesians 4:29, we read that we are not to let unwholesome words proceed from our mouths. We need to bring our bodies, to include our tongues into submission. We must not use words that tear down or that are vulgar, but rather use words to edify and build up.
