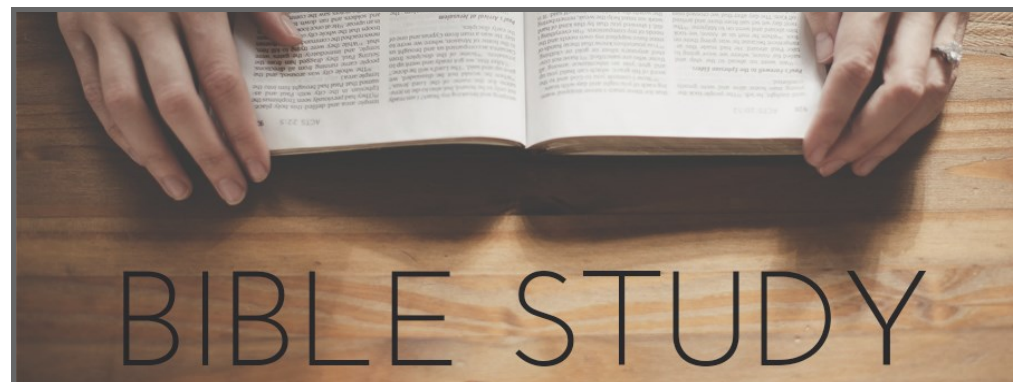







Classics Visit Museum
