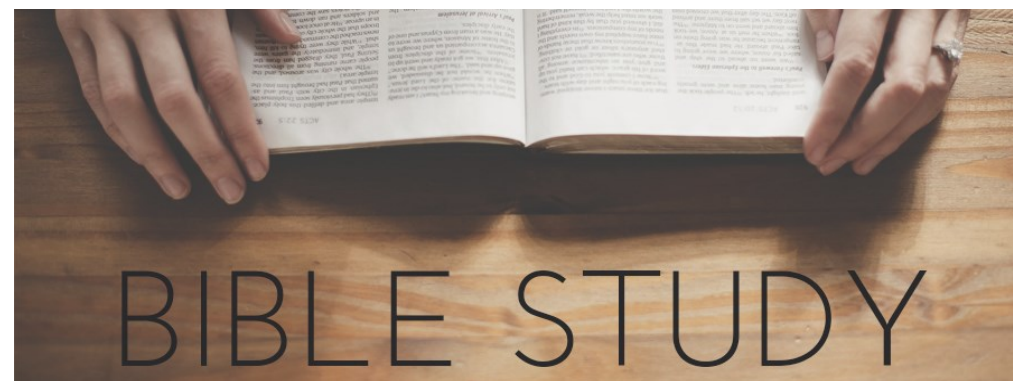

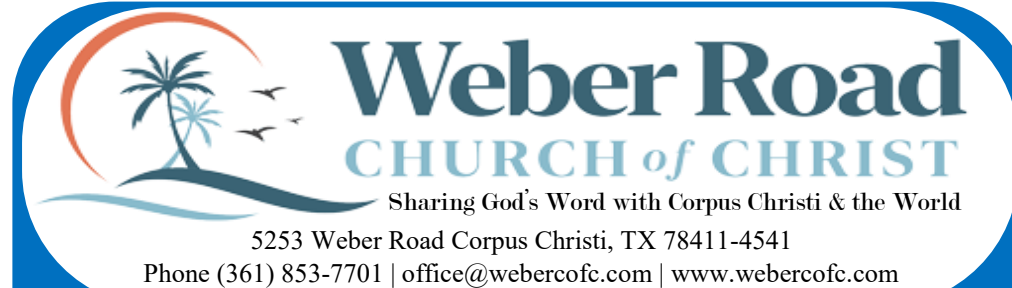

4 Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. 5 Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; 6 do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. *Philippians 4:4-9 (ESV)*

Joy! Are you joyous? Has anything robbed you of your joy?

What does it truly mean to be joyful? Is joy just being extremely happy? There are a several questions that we can contemplate around joy. We all are seeking joy. There are also a variety of definitions of joy and how to obtain joy. Joy can be found in possessions or money. Joy can be found in our hobbies. Joy can be found in our family and friends. Joy can be found in food. Paul wrote Philippians with an abundance of joy, yet his circumstances were not ideal. Paul wrote this letter in prison, probably under house arrest in Rome. How then could he write about rejoicing? Paul chose joy over circumstance.

Joy is a choice! We can choose to be joyful or fearful. Paul knew that joy outside of Christ was not true joy. Those circumstances change, which causes our joy to change. Yet God never changes (James 1:16-18)! We ought to choose joy in spite of our circumstances. This concept is not easy. It is easy to look at the things that are happening around us and allow the circumstances to rob us of our joy. This week, I want you to choose joy over circumstance. Do not let fear, anxiety, or anything else rob you of your joy in the Lord. Notice the remainder of this verse, let your requests be made known to God. If your joy is gone, pray to God to help you choose joy. Pray to God to overcome the fears, anxiety, illness, or anything else. I pray today that you choose Joy!

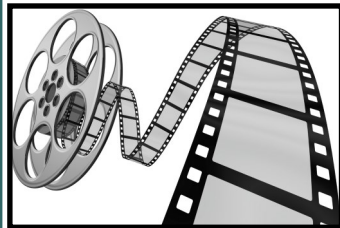
