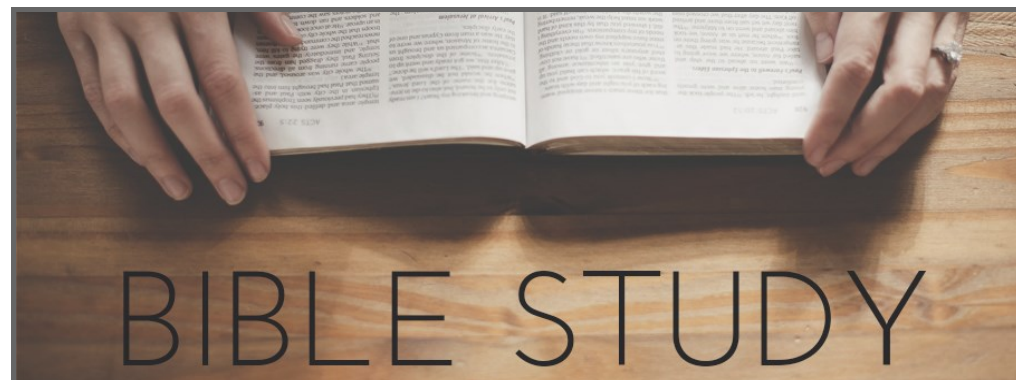

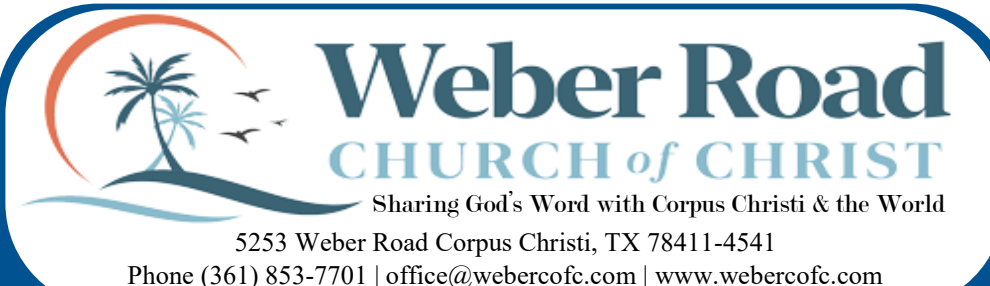

THE POWER OF THE INVITATION KENNETH PINCKLEY

Who does not love a personal invitation? At our house, we have formal invitations hanging on our fridge to past graduations and a special wedding this past summer. We loved receiving these invitations! We love being invited over to eat after service or at your house. We couldn't wait for our house to be finished so we could finally return the favor. There is a special feeling when we receive an invitation. Yet do we have the same feeling about the Lord's invitation?

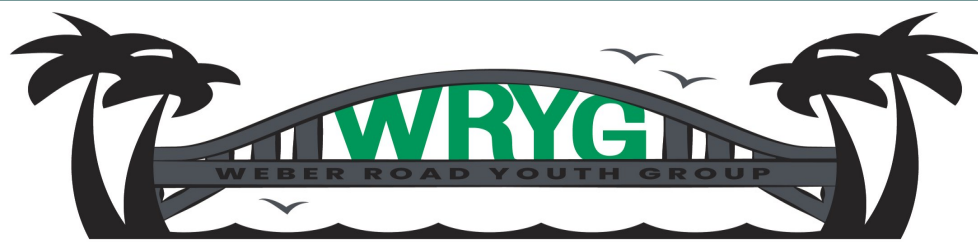
I have heard the hardest step in Church is the first step out of the pew to come forward. Why is it so hard to accept the Lord's invitation? Is it a matter of embarrassment? Are we ashamed as to what others think? Are we guilty of judging those who bravely come forward?

Notice John writes in Revelation 22:17 "The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price. (ESV)" The Spirit and the Bride are calling us to come. Are we inviting others to come as we sing the invitational song? The invitation is not just a way to end the sermon, it is not simply a tradition. But is the invitation still important to us?

This invitation is actually from the Lord Jesus, not the preacher. Notice Matthew 11 :28ff "Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. (NKJV)." In this world, we will become heavily burdened and weak. Jesus is calling us at our weakest to come to Him. Allow Him to take our heavy burden in exchange for His light burden. Is this invitation important? Yes, because it is the Lord who invites us to "come".

We need to encourage one another to accept the Lord's invitation. We need to be praying for those who need the Lord to come home. We need to lovingly accept those home.

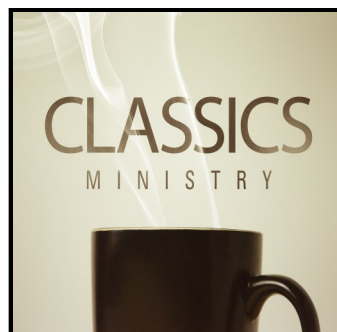

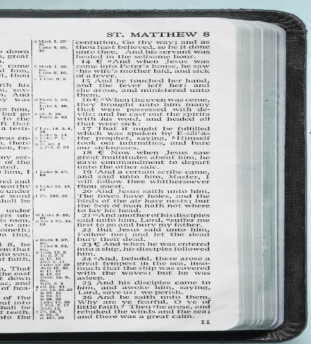
