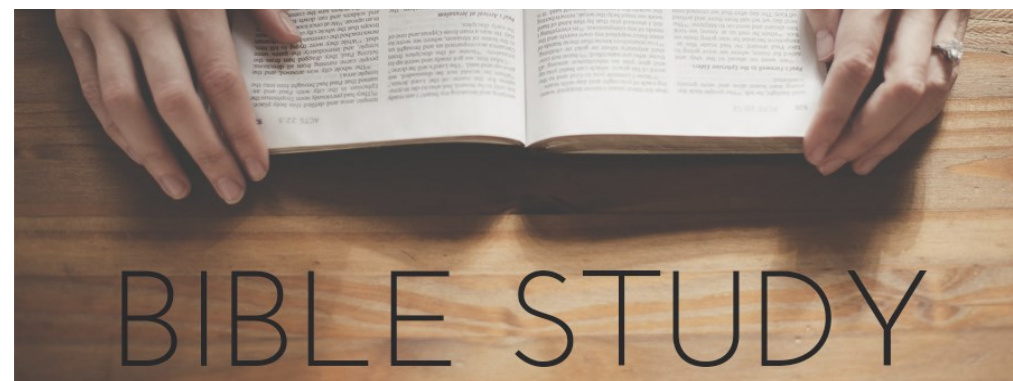

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰ For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.” Matthew 11:28-30 [ESV]

It started around mile 6 or 7. The weight of the pack started to weigh him down. His shoulders and back began to throb. He slowly kept putting his blistered feet in front of the other. At mile 12, he was finally able to shed the weight and rest. It is a right of passage for many Soldiers to endure a 12 mile ruck march carrying a heavy load. We started training for this back in week 1 with just a simple mile and we worked up to 12 miles. Any Soldier will tell you that rucking takes a toll on your body no matter how often you march. They look toward the end, when they can shed the weight off their shoulders.

In our lives, we can become burden and weighed down. Weigh down with stress of this world. We carry these burdens every day and everywhere. Jesus wants our heavy burden. Jesus wants to carry the load for us. A burden that is too great for us to bear. Unfortunately, we find it hard to give up the burden. Are you willing to give it over to Jesus? Are you willing to give the burden of sin and the guilt over to our Passover Lamb? Not only has Jesus said, I will take your burden and give you rest, the Church was established for us to help one another. Do you need help? Will you accept the Lord’s invitation to lay down the weight of sin that entangles you? ~KP

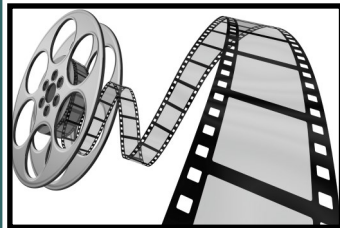
