FEAR

MATTHEW 14:22-33

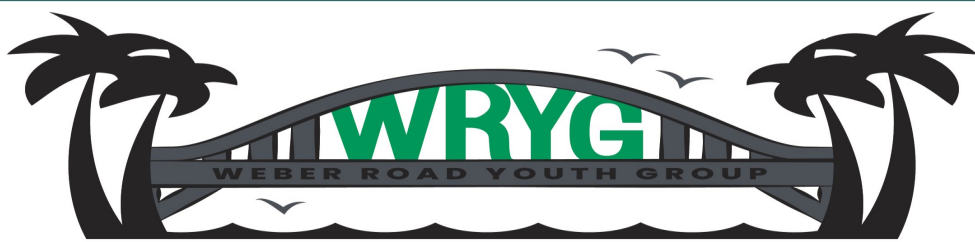
One year ago! This week last year was the last week of what we knew was normal. During the year, there was a huge focus on fear and the unknown. How did you handle this storm of fear? How did the Church handle it? Storms in life happen. A storm could be a medical diagnosis, the loss of a job, the loss of a loved one, or a marriage falling apart. The question is how do we handle these storms of life.

In Matthew 14, the Apostles were sailing in the midst of a sudden storm. The storm was bad enough that it struck fear in these men, some of which were fishermen. In the middle of this storm they see Jesus walking on the water. Peter cries out a challenge to walk on the water to Jesus. As Peter begins his journey on the water he begins to look around at the storm. His focus shifts and he begins to sink. As he sinks, he cries out to Jesus to be saved. Jesus reaches down to save him.

I believe we can take away two thoughts. In the middle of the storm our focus needs to be on Jesus. It is easy to focus on the storm. We can focus on the fear. Yet in Hebrews we read that our focus must be on Jesus because He is the author and perfecter of our faith. The second key take away is that we need face our fear. We can become comfortable in the boat. It is our safety net. Yet Jesus is calling us to step out on face onto the waters of the unknown.

Are you still sitting comfortably in the boat? It might be time for us to step out on faith. Are you sinking in the midst of the storm? Cry out to Jesus and he will carry you back to the boat. -Kenneth Pinckley

YOUTH FAMILY DEVOTIONAL

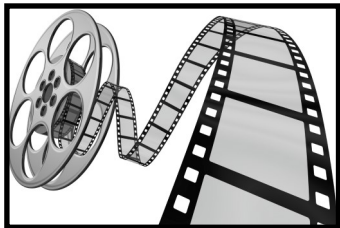
Sunday, March 21 [6-8 PM]

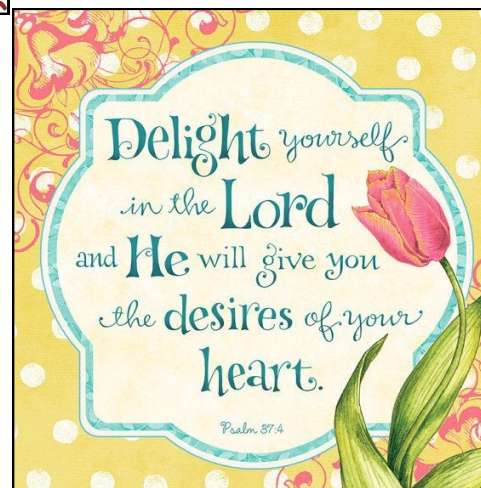
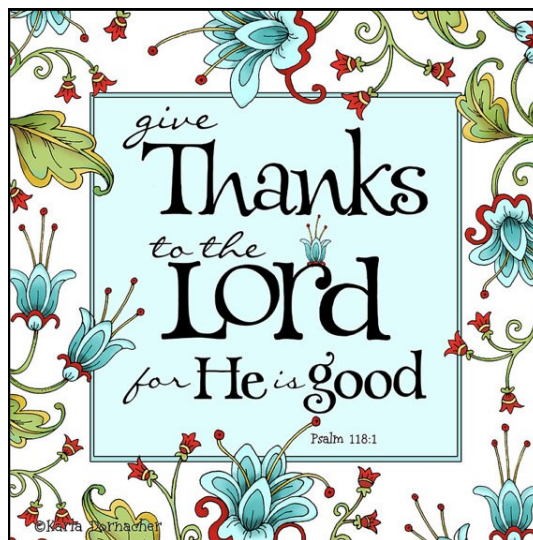

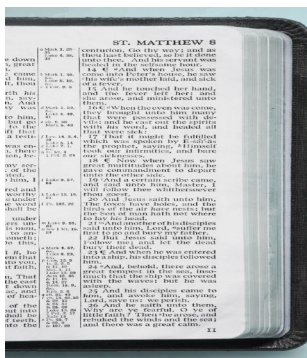
