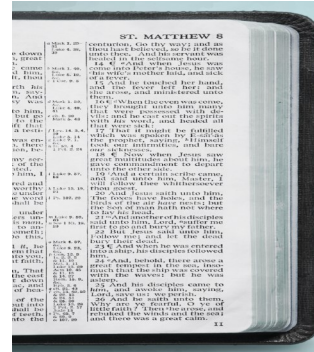
POLVADO-DOUBRAVA CAMP SESSION
