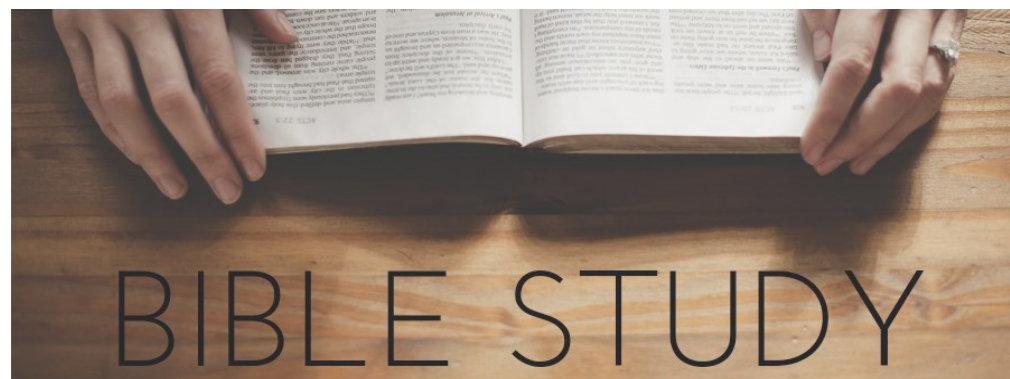

TEXAS BBQ

There is a place outside of New Braunfels, Texas that has some amazing BBQ. We love just about everything we order. Recently, I tried my hand at smoking some pulled pork, yes I grew up East of the Mississippi on some pulled pork. The process started the night before with preparing the roast, and seasoning the roast. The next morning, I started my charcoal at 7 AM. After the coals were hot, I put the roast on for a long soak in the smoke, for about 8 hours. I would go out occasionally and check on the roast, check on the temperature, and patiently wait.

Often, as a Christian we want things to happen quickly. We want to mature quickly. We want others to understand the importance of God quickly. Yet it takes time. It takes effort. It takes patience. Paul, in 2 Timothy 2:15 writes, "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." There is work for Christians to do to be able to grow and mature. In Ephesians 4:11-16, Paul describes a maturation process. We know that this takes time. In 1 Corinthians 3, Paul uses different illustrations that describe growth. All of these examples, take time for a Christian to grow.

I want you to understand that like a good BBQ, Christian strength takes time, patience, and effort. Yet do not get discouraged. Because like good BBQ, the end result is well worth it. -Kenneth Pinckley

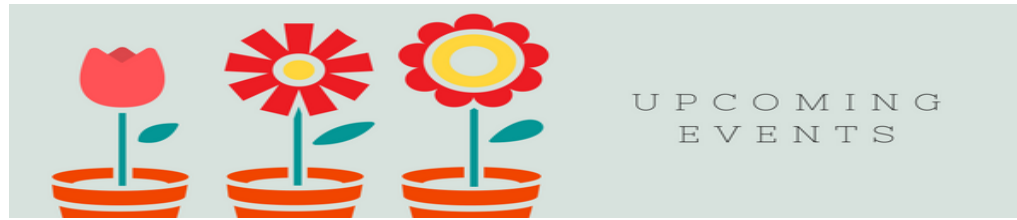

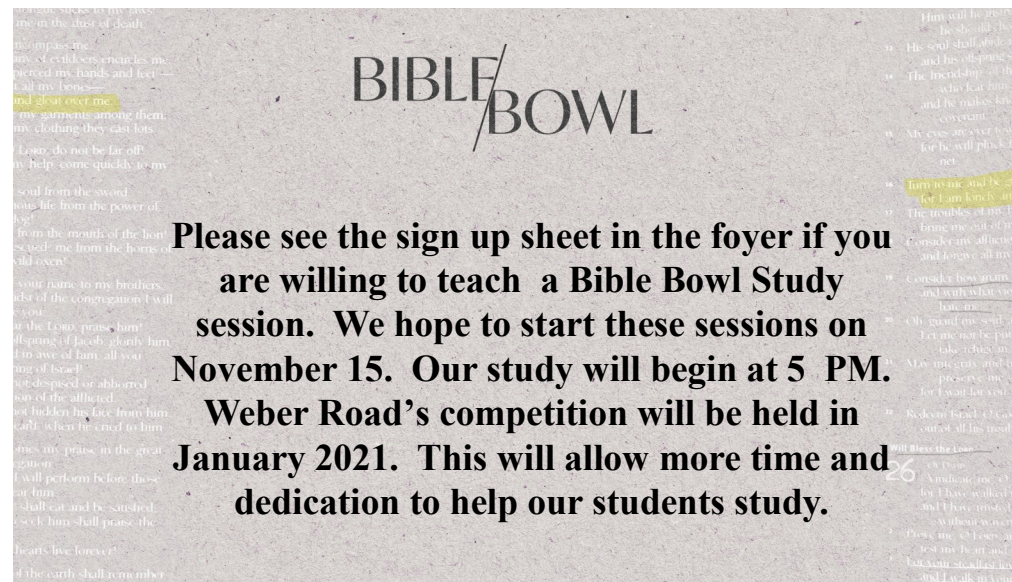
