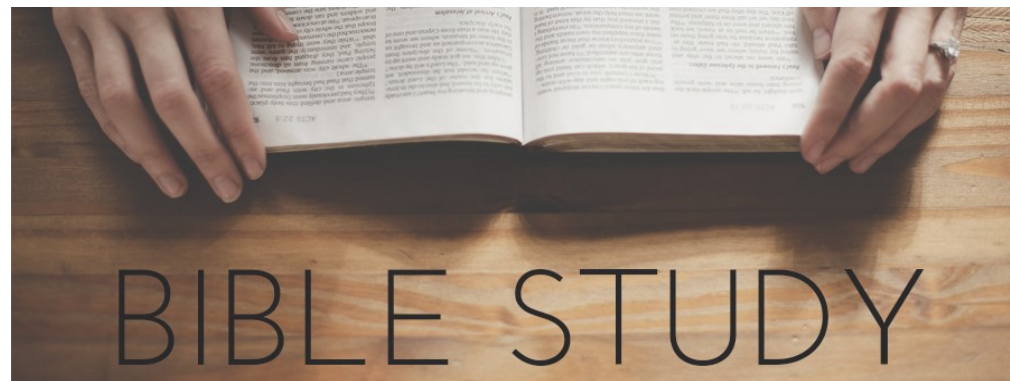

REVELATION
A LETTER TO THE SEVEN CHURCHES

Last week, we started to look at these letters to the seven Churches in Asian Minor; Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Sardis, Thyatira, Philadelphia, and Laodicea. I want to lay some groundwork and introductory information before we look at each of these letters more thoroughly. Revelation is a book often overlooked. It contains symbolism, numbers, colors, and other things that many find confusing. Yet it is interesting that this book is written by the same author who wrote John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." In Revelation 1 we see several important pieces of information about this book. 1) It is written by John (1:1, 4); 2) It is a revelation or revealing from Jesus Christ (1:1); 3) the things must take place soon (1:1-3). There are several different views of how to interpret this letter. Several of these views lead to false doctrines and take the book and material out of context. When understanding the Biblical narrative we must understand the historical background behind the text. Things must mean something to the original audience, so we must understand that Revelation must mean something to the time period in which it was written. Revelation was most likely written in A.D. 90 during Domitian's rule as the Roman Emperor. Also, there was widespread persecution of Christians and the practice of Emperor worship. The theme of Revelation can simply be summarized as "Christians win." We may face persecution or death but a faithful Christian will gain a crown of life. Oh what great comfort to us! Next week we will further study the letter to Ephesus. ~Kenneth
