






Last week, in my sermon we looked over the letter to the Church in Ephesus. This can be called the loveless Church. A Church that lost their love, zeal, and motivation for God. Jesus told them to remember their past zeal and love. Then they were told to repent or change from their past, and then to repeat those same actions or else their candlestick will be removed. As I pointed out, we need to always remember our love and passion for Christ. I want to encourage you again to remember!

As we continue in Revelation, Smyrna is the next church mentioned. Again there is a similar introduction. It is written to the angel of the Church by "The first and last, the one who died and came to life." Another reflection back to Jesus. Jesus is the beginning and the end. He is immortal. He was in the beginning with God; John 1:1-3. All things were created through him; Col. 1:15-20. Smyrna was the center of Emperor worship with a large population of Jewish, who were militant to Christians. They were guilty of putting Polycarp to death on the Sabbath Day for proclaiming Christ.

The Church in Smyrna was a church that was being persecuted. They were in poverty, the poorest of the poor. Yet through Jesus they are rich. Jesus tells them that they will suffer for 10 days, a short definite amount of time. Revelation 2:10 gives us the idea that our faithfulness will lead to death, consider again Polycarp. Now it also means that we must remain faithful every day to include persecution or death. If we remain faithful we will receive the Crown of Life or victors crown.
