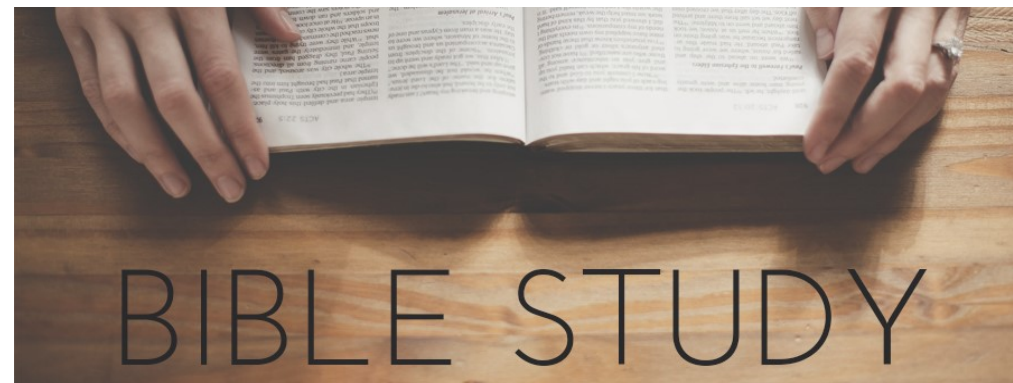

LETTERS

Sending letters has dwindled in popularity. There are still a few who love sending letters. I know personally I love receiving letters. While I was in training, I loved getting letters written by family and friends. In fact, I have a box with those letters at home. There is just something about getting a letter written by someone you love!

As we study the New Testament, we have 13 “books” that are Paul’s letters to churches. These letters contained encouragement, but also had theological discussion. He wrote letters to check on the church; 1 Thessalonians 3. He wrote to show hypocrisy; Galatians 2. He wrote to show sin in the congregation; 1 Corinthians 5. If Weber Road, or you personally were to receive a letter from an Apostle, what would be written in the letter?

John in Revelation 2 and 3 wrote 7 letters to 7 churches in Asia Minor. In these 7 letters, Jesus reveals to John a message. Jesus knows the deeds or works of the church. There is an aspect that the church needs to fix, except Smyrna and Philadelphia. Then there was a promise for those that overcome. The church in Ephesus left their first love. The church in Pergamum did not rebuke false teachers. The church in Thyatira participated in idol worship. The church in Sardis was dead. The church in Laodicea was lukewarm. There is definitely more to unpacked from each of these letters. Each of these had something they needed to fix. They lost their passion. They did not truly remove false teachers from their midst. They did not continue to work. They were not hot nor cold. Yet in each of these letters there is a promise. If the church were to repent or overcome tribulations, they will have the promise of being with Jesus. They would receive a white stone symbolizing victory or freedom. As we study these letters let us remember that there is still time to change. Yet everyday this time is dwindling. If you need to repent, please do not wait. ~Kenneth
