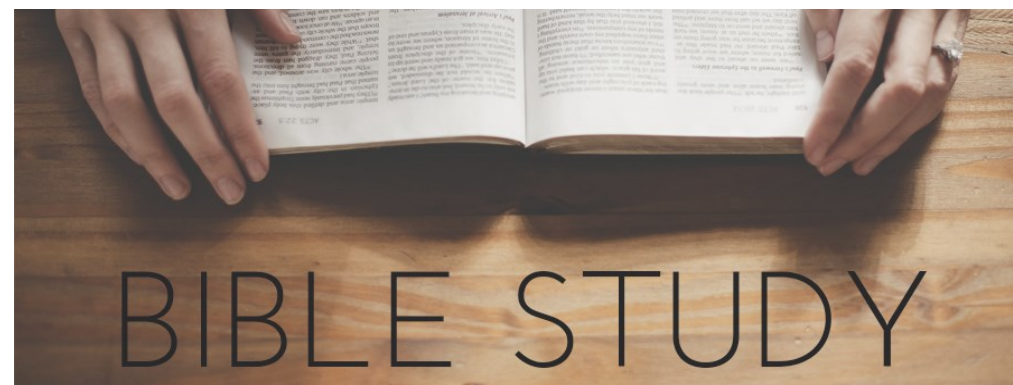

Pergamum: Satan's Place

Pergamum was the capital city of the Roman province of Asia. It was the center of Emperor worship. The first temple dedicated to emperor worship was built there in 29 BC. The city was considered the great intellectual center of the seven churches of Asia. It was also the center of the worship of the "god of healing," thus, one of the reasons we can understand the statement "where Satan's seat is."

The Church held fast the name of Christ and His authority and did not deny his name, even in the face of persecution. Antipas was a faithful witness that was killed for his faith. The word "witness" means something or someone serving as evidence, thus it is not the witness of the apostles but was a witness in that when he lived the people would say "there is a man of Christ."

Yet, the church in Pergamum still had some issues. This congregation allowed false doctrine to come into their teaching. The text mentions Baal worship and the teachings of the Nicolaitans. Baal worship is also mentioned in Numbers 25:14; cf 31:16. The idea was to compromise their beliefs and participate in idolatry. Nicolaitans similarly were teaching to compromise their beliefs. We see two different sects trying to get Christians to compromise their faith. The warning to the church is to repent of their attitude toward false doctrine or else God will remove their candlestick. Today, there are many false doctrines being taught so we must carefully discern what is truth. Jesus states that He is the way, the TRUTH and the life, and no one comes to the father except through Him (John 14:6). We must be diligent to study to understand and know the truth found in God's word (2 Timothy 2:15).
