

"Where were you when the world stop turning?"

For many, this day 20 years ago, lingers in our head. We remember this day for so many reasons. For many Americans, we watched as the second plane hit the South tower. We were shocked and mourned as we watched the towers fall. We heard countless stories of heroism on that day. I could tell you about the firemen who rescued so many and still continued up, or Rick Rescorla and his security team that after leading Morgan Stanley employees safely out was last seen going up further while singing in order to keep people calm. 


