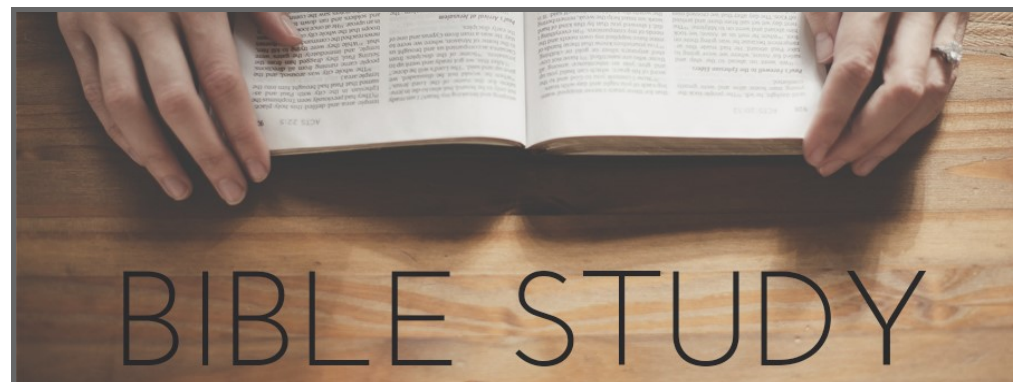

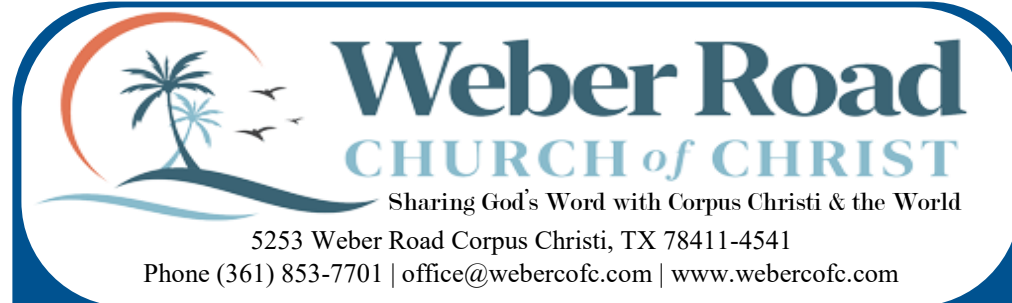

HOW DOES GOD BUILD A BODY?

Ekklesia (ek-klay-see-ah) is a Greek termed that is often identified with the assembly or church. The word basically means a gathering of citizens called out from their homes into some public place, an assembly. In a Christian context, it is a gathering of Christians for a religious meeting or worship. The word is used 116 times in the New Testament.

In Matthew 16:13-20, we read about a beautiful confession of Peter declaring Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God. Jesus tells Peter that based upon that confession, I will build my church. Peter is used as a catalyst, along with the other Apostles, to build the Church. Notice the singularity of the word, Jesus used in Matthew 16:18. There is one Church. There is one body. Paul mentions this singular body in Ephesians 4:1-6. So we must ask ourselves are we in the Body of Christ. We must ask if Weber Road Church of Christ is THE church of Christ, based in scripture.

How can we know we are THE church? God has laid out the plans for the Church in scripture. God has given us the blueprints. There is a push at times to change the church to fit better in our cities or cultures. The body of Christ is not about entertaining or catering to certain ideologies or generations. The body of Christ is to encourage, edify, strengthen the members. We are to praise God. We are to worship our creator. We are to seek and bring the lost to Jesus.
