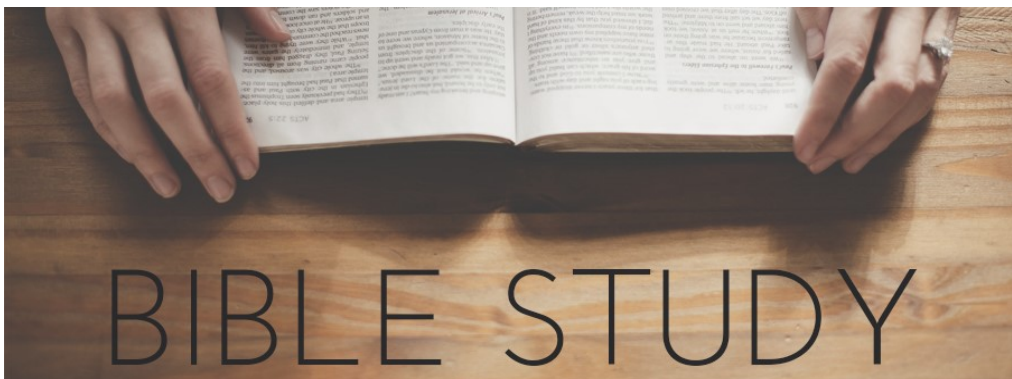

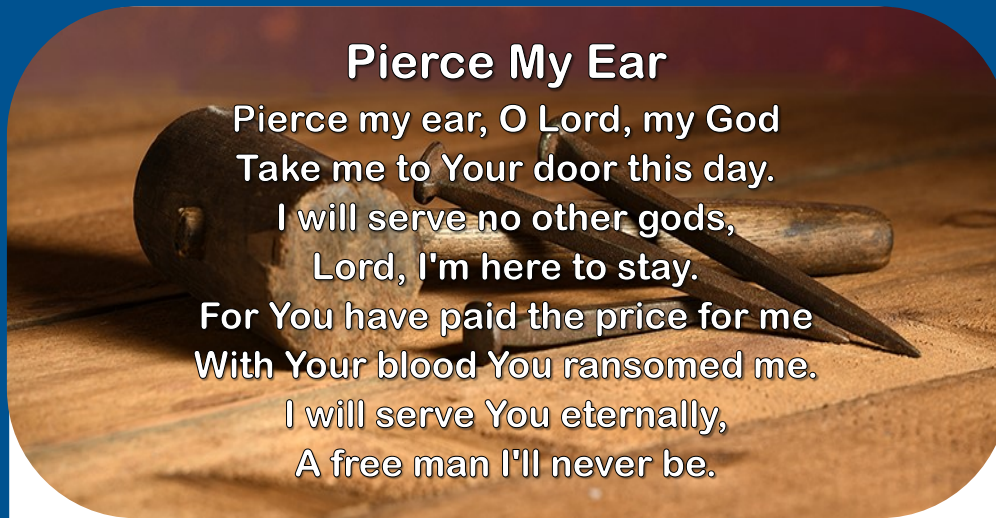

This might be a new song to some. It is a pretty song to sing with a deep message. We understand from 1 Corinthians 14, that we must sing with our heart and our mind. We must understand the words that we sing as we sing them to each other. We know from Ephesians 5:19 and Colossians 3:16, that our singing is to teach and admonish those who hear us sing. Singing for a Christian is so significant.

I first heard this song while in Middle school. As you read through the lyrics you may find it weird that we are singing to God to pierce our ear. In Exodus 21:2-6, there is a written law about Hebrew slaves serving their master. The Hebrew slave were to serve for six years and on the seventh he was to be released free. The one exception is if the slave "plainly says" that he loves his master. If the slave loves serving his master he will be taken to a doorpost and have his ear pierced to show his dedication and serve to his master as his "freed slave".

This song is describing our love for God. We are crying out to God in prayer to say that we will not serve another God or master but the one true and living God. We will be His forever and ever. Are you this day willing to serve God? Are you ready to belong to Him? This is not an easy work. We cannot expect to be a "slave" and not continue to serve or work. I want to encourage you to examine your life. What are you serving. How can you be a better servant to God? Maybe you have let other things take you away from working in His Kingdom on earth.
