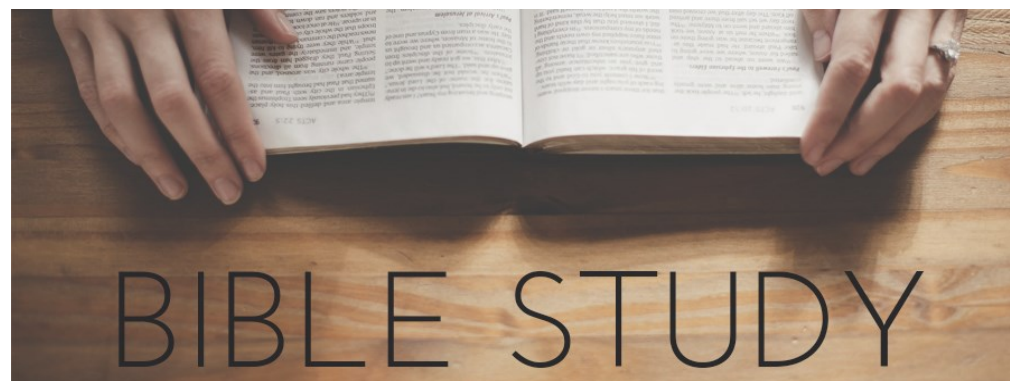

I Owe a Debt

Are you ready for a shocker? America is in debt. As of 2020, Americas debt was around 28 trillion dollars. A number that is very hard to fathom. If you spent 1 million dollars a day, it will take you 2,700 years to spend 1 trillion dollars. The weight of a trillion dollars in 1 dollar bills would weigh 2.2 billion pounds. Have you got a mental picture yet?

We sometimes sing in church a song called "He Paid a Debt". In Matthew 18:21-35, we have recorded a parable about the unforgiving servant. In this parable we read about a master who had a servant who owed 10,000 talents, or a great sum of money. Some calculate a talent as 20 years wages or about \$1,000-\$30,000 in todays currency. A debt that could not be paid back. The master seeing his servant and knowing completely wiped it away. One would think the servant would be grateful for this great gift of forgiveness. Yet the servant found someone who owed him 100 denarii, a significantly smaller amount. Yet this servant began to demand payment. The end of the story is that the servant who had his debt forgiven was thrown into jail until the debt was paid.

There is a cost to sin. Because every one of us sins, each one of us owes a debt. That debt is death. We can look at Old Testament examples and begin to see the pattern of death and sacrifices, yet animal sacrifices could not pay our debt. We needed a perfect sacrifice. We needed a sacrifice without blemish. We got that sacrifice through the death of Jesus. Jesus willingly took the debt of the world and paid it off. Now what are we going to do with this great news? Are we going to rejoice? Are we going to go scream it from a mountain? Are we going to go tell others?
