

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. ¹⁷ For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith." Romans 1:16-17 (ESV)

Have you ever seen something on fire? Have you stood by a campfire or bonfire and felt the heat? Fire consumes. In dry conditions, a single spark can start a roaring fire that consumes thousands of acres. In other contexts we say that a person is on fire. I know in basketball, I have used that saying to speak about someone who cannot miss a shot. That person is on fire! Another concept behind the context of fire is passionate. They are excited. They are eager. I can name several things in which I am passionate. I am passionate about Alabama football, about fishing for bass, and grilling. What is your passion?

As we consider these various things, we get excited. We want to talk about these things. We want to share with others the joy that we have in these hobbies or other things. As we look in Romans 1, Paul uses this expression of being on fire. In verse 15, Paul writes that he is eager to share the message of God. He figuratively was on fire to spread the message of God. I am blessed to know several who are on fire to share the message of God. In fact, when I call some that is all they want to talk about on the phone. We say that we are passionate about being a Christian. We say that we love God. We say that we are "unashamed of the gospel." Yet if we are truly passionate about God and His gospel are we passionately sharing his message! Paul says that he is passionate to share this message because this message contains the power of God. He is unashamed because this message saves.

The question for us today, is how is our fire. Sometimes a campfire begins to die down. Sometimes the fire starts to fade. Sometimes as a Christian our light starts to fade. Yet similarly to a campfire, we might need to throw small sticks on the fire to get it going again. Sometimes in our lives we need a fire jump start. What do you need in your spiritual life to revive the fire? How can we help you?

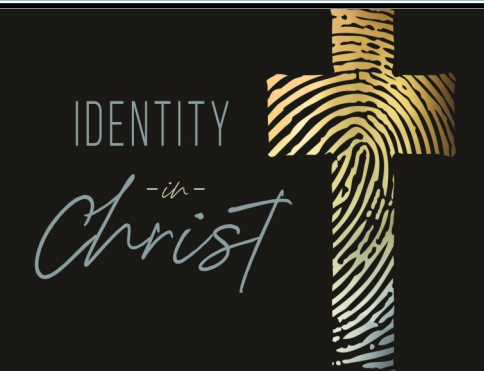
