## Farewell Message from the Pinckley's

Let us continue to love one another as He has loved us. Let us share our faith in our community and be dedicated to the church. Be a good worker (2:15; 22-26). Flee desires of the flesh. Live with a pure and upright heart. Pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace. Preach the word (2 Timothy 4:1-5). Be ready with a defense. Be ready to share the good news of Jesus. Endure sound doctrine and share the inspired Word.
- 3) Paul's Final Words (2 Tim 4:6-8). So now what? Why must I remain faithful? Why do I need to be a worker or a good soldier? So we can confidently say at the final judgement, "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith. Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award me on that Day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved His appearing."

Here are a few things I want to leave you. Don't hesitate to call or reach out. We still love and care for each of you. Don't be a stranger now. We will continue to pray for you. Remember God Loves you (John 3:16, Rom 8:37-39). Dedicate your life to him. Be baptized for the remission of sins (Gal. 2:20, Rom. 6:5-11). Repent of your sins (Acts 2:38, 1 John 1:5-10).

**Colossians 1:1-14,** Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, <sup>2</sup> To the saints and faithful brothers in Christ at Colossae: Grace to you and peace from God our Father.

<sup>3</sup> We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, <sup>4</sup> since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love that you have for all the saints, <sup>5</sup> because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel, <sup>6</sup> which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and increasing—as it also does among you, since the day you heard it and understood the grace of God in truth, <sup>7</sup> just as you learned it from Epaphras our belovedfellow servant. He is a faithful minister of Christ on your behalf <sup>8</sup> and has made known to us your love in the Spirit.

<sup>9</sup> And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will In all spiritual wisdom and understanding, <sup>10</sup> so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; <sup>11</sup> being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; <sup>12</sup> giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. <sup>13</sup> He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, <sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
